- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 60-02-07 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to public warehouse licenses; and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 60-02-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 6 60-02-07. Public warehouse license How obtained Fee Financial statement.
- An annual license must be obtained from the The commission for shall license each public warehouse in operation in this state. The license expires on July thirty-first of each year.
 - 1. a. The commission shall stagger by lot the expiration date of all licenses issued for the period beginning August 1, 2015, and ending July 31, 2016, so that one-half of all the licenses issued expire on July 31, 2016, and one-half of all the licenses issued expire on July 31, 2017. Thereafter, all licenses issued under this section must be for a period of two years and terminate on the thirty-first day of July in the year of expiration.
 - b. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of subdivision a, the commission shall license a warehouse annually, for the first six years of the warehouse's operation.
 - (2) An initial <u>annual</u> license application that becomes effective on or after June first does not expire until July thirty-first of the following calendar year.
 - 2. No license may describe more than one public warehouse nor grant permission to operate any public warehouse other than the one described.
