 personindividual through the medium or service of an employment agent.

 association in this state engaged for hire or compensation in the business of

 PersonsIndividuals seeking employment or changing employment, with

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 information or other service enabling or tending to enable such

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6	(1) An individual, firm, corporation, limited liability company, or association
7	employing individuals to render part-time or temporary services to or for a
8	third person, if the personindividual, firm, corporation, limited liability
9	company, or association employing the individuals, in addition to wages or
10	salaries, pays social security and unemployment insurance taxes, provides
11	workforce safety and insurance coverage, and is responsible for the acts of
12	the employees while rendering services to or for a third person. The term
13	"employment agent" or "employment agency" does not include a person
14	(2) An individual, firm, corporation, limited liability company, or association
15	charging service fees or any other charges exclusively to employers ; or a
16	person.
17	(3) An individual, firm, corporation, limited liability company, or association
18	licensed or certified by the department of human services to provide
19	employment related services, to the extent the employment-related services
20	are being provided for the clientele identified by the department in the
21	issuance of the license or certificate.
22	5. "Gross misconduct" means misconduct involving assault and battery, the malicious
23	destruction of property, or the theft of money or property.
