HOUSE BILL NO. 1284 (Representatives Bellew, Boehning, Dockter, B. Koppelman, Olson, Schmidt)

AN ACT to amend and reenact subsection 2 of section 21-03-10.1 and section 21-03-13 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the contents of bond election ballots.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 2 of section 21-03-10.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

 The A bond election ballot form authorized in substantially the form prescribed in section 21-03-13 is sufficient must be used in a school district bond election. After approval of the initial resolution by the number of qualified electors required by section 21-03-07, the proceeds of the bond issue may be used only for the purpose and in the manner designated by the school plan except as herein provided.

SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 21-03-13 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
