## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. If Senate Bill No. 2025 does not become effective, a new section to chapter
   4-12.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 8 Placement or location of a hive Limitation.
- 9 <u>1. a. A beekeeper may not place or locate a hive within two miles [3.22 kilometers] of</u>
  10 an occupied residence.
  - (1) This subdivision does not apply to a residence owned or occupied by the beekeeper.
  - (2) This subdivision does not apply if the beekeeper obtains from the owner of the residence a written statement providing permission for the location or placement of the hive and files the statement with the commissioner. A statement filed under this subdivision is valid only for the calendar year in which it is filed.
    - b. A beekeeper may not place or locate a hive within 2 miles [3.22 kilometers] of a residential facility, a daycare facility, or an operating school.

  - a. Note the date and time of the complaint;
