- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 4 of section 39-21-39 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to windshield tinting.

## 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 4 of section 39-21-39 of the North Dakota Century 5 Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
  - 4. An individual may not operate a motor vehicle with any object, material, or tinting displayed, affixed, or applied on the front windshield or any window unless the object, material, or tinting in conjunction with the windshield upon which it is displayed, affixed, or applied has a light transmittance of at least seventy percent to the line on the windshield designated AS-1 or six inches from the top of the visor or the object, material, or tinting in conjunction with a window other than the windshield upon which it is displayed, affixed, or applied has a light transmittance of at least fiftytwenty percent. This subsection does not apply to windows behind the operator if the motor vehicle is equipped with outside mirrors on both sides that meet the requirements of section 39-21-38. The director may provide exemptions from this subsection for front side windows for medical reasons, antique cars, law enforcement, a bail bond agent, and an individual providing private investigative or security services.
