- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide student loan repayment programs for health care professionals; to
- 2 repeal chapters 43-12.2 and 43-17.2 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to loan
- 3 repayment programs for nurse practitioners, physician assistants, certified nurse midwives, and
- 4 physicians; to provide for a continuing appropriation; and to provide for an application.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1**.
- 7 <u>Student loan repayment programs Health care professionals.</u>
- 8 The health council shall administer student loan repayment programs, as established by
- 9 this chapter, for healthcare professionals willing to provide services in cities that have a defined
- 10 need for such services.
- 11 **SECTION 2.**
- 12 **Application process.**
- The health council shall develop an application process for cities seeking to fill health care
- 14 <u>needs and for healthcare professionals willing to provide necessary services in exchange for</u>
- 15 <u>benefits under a student loan repayment program.</u>
- 16 **SECTION 3.**
- 17 Cities Selection criteria Matching funds.
- 18 <u>1. The health council shall establish criteria to be used in selecting cities for participation</u>
- in a program. The criteria must include:
- 20 <u>a.</u> The number of healthcare professionals, by specified field, already providing
- 21 <u>services in the city;</u>
- b. Access to healthcare services in the city and the surrounding area; and
- c. The level of support from the city and the surrounding area.

1 The health council may consult with public and private sector entities in establishing 2 criteria and evaluating needs based on the criteria. 3 <u>3.</u> A city may not be selected for participation unless it contractually commits to provide 4 matching funds equal to the amount required for a loan repayment program in 5 accordance with section 6 of this Act. 6 **SECTION 4.** 7 Cities - Eligibility for participation - Priority. 8 In selecting cities for participation in a program, the health council shall give priority, in 9 descending order, to those cities that meet the selection criteria, or to a practice with a focus on 10 an underserved population and: 11 Have fewer than fifteen thousand residents: 1. 12 2. Have at least fifteen thousand residents, but fewer than thirty thousand residents; 13 and 14 Do not belong to a metropolitan statistical area; or 15 Have at least thirty thousand residents. 16 **SECTION 5.** 17 Healthcare professionals - Selection criteria. 18 <u>1.</u> The health council shall establish criteria to be used in selecting healthcare 19 professionals for participation in a student loan repayment program. The criteria must 20 include: 21 The healthcare professional's specialty; <u>a.</u> 22 The need for the healthcare professional's specialty within a city; b. 23 The healthcare professional's education and experience; <u>C.</u> 24 <u>d.</u> The health care professional's date of availability and anticipated term of 25 availability; and 26 The health care professional's willingness to accept medicare and Medicaid 27 assignments, if applicable. 28 The health council shall give priority to healthcare professionals who graduated from 2. 29 an institution of higher education in this state. 30 **SECTION 6.**

- 2 it existed on July 31, 2015. Any physician loan repayment contract entered into before August 1,
- 3 2015, is governed by chapter 43-17.2, as it existed on July 31, 2015.
