- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 57-38 and a new subdivision to
- 2 subsection 7 of section 57-38-30.3 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to a parent's
- 3 choice individual income tax credit for qualified educational expenses; and to provide an
- 4 effective date.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 57-38 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 7 and enacted as follows:
- 8 Parent's choice income tax credit for qualified educational expenses.
- 1. A taxpayer is allowed a credit against the tax imposed under section 57-38-30.3 in the
 amount of qualified educational expenses paid by the taxpayer for each qualifying
 child during the taxable year.
- 16 <u>3.</u> For purposes of this section:
- a. "Qualified educational expenses" means the amount expended for each
 qualifying child for books and tuition relating to the child's education at a
 nonpublic school.
- <u>"Qualifying child" means a child who was a nonpublic school student under the</u>
 <u>age of eighteen at the end of the taxable year. A qualifying child must be related</u>
 <u>to the taxpayer by blood or marriage.</u>

1	<u>4.</u>	The credit allowed under this section may not exceed a taxpayer's liability as
2		determined under this chapter for the taxable year.
3	<u>5.</u>	The aggregate amount of credits allowed under this section may not exceed
4		ten million dollars in any calendar year. Credits subject to this limitation must be
5		determined based upon the date of the qualified expenditure.
6	<u>6.</u>	To receive the tax credit provided under this section, a taxpayer shall claim the credit
7		in the form and manner prescribed by the tax commissioner.
8	SECTION 2. A new subdivision to subsection 7 of section 57-38-30.3 of the North Dakota	
9	Century Code is created and enacted as follows:	
10		Parent's choice income tax credit for qualified educational expenses under
11		section 1 of this Act.
12	SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act is effective for taxable years beginning after	
13	December 31, 2014.
