SB2253 appropriates \$2,250,000 to expand the Healthy Families Home Visitation Program to all human service regions.

The Healthy Families Home Visitation Program is currently funded by the department in two regions in the state. SB2253 provides an appropriation of \$2,250,000 from the General Fund for the department to expand the Healthy Families Home Visitation Program to the six remaining human service regions at funding levels that are consistent with the two regions the department currently provides funding for.

SB2253 provides \$2,250,000 from the General Fund for the department to expand the Healthy Families Home Visitation Program to the six remaining human service regions in the state. For the 2017-2019 biennium the department would incur General Fund grant expenses of \$2,250,000 to sustain the Healthy Families Home Visitation Program for six regions in the state.
