5 SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 12.1-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

- In determining an individual's age for purposes of this title, the individual's date of birth as provided by United States government or a state government in the form of a birth certificate, entry document, or state-issued identification the any of the following is presumed to be the individual's legal date of birth. This:
 - The United States government in the form of a tribal identification document, military identification, passport, passport card, permanent resident card, certificate of United States citizenship, certificate of naturalization, border crossing card, visa, or other entry document that includes the individual's date of birth;
 - A state government in the form of a birth certificate or other state-issued identification that includes the individual's date of birth; or
 - A foreign government in the form of a passport, driver's license, or other foreign government-issued identity document that includes the individual's date of birth.
- The presumption in subsection 1 may be rebutted by clear and convincing evidence to the contrary.

SECTION 2. A new section to chapter 14-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
