- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-06.1-06 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to fees for speeding.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 39-06.1-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **39-06.1-06. Amount of statutory fees.**

7 The fees required for a noncriminal disposition under section 39-06.1-02 or 39-06.1-03 must8 be as follows:

- 9 1. For a nonmoving violation as defined in section 39-06.1-08, a fee of twenty dollars
- 10 except for a violation of any traffic parking regulation on any state charitable or penal
- 11 institution property or on the state capitol grounds, a fee in the amount of five dollars,
- 12 excluding a violation of subsection 10 of section 39-01-15.
- 13 2. For a moving violation as defined in section 39-06.1-09, a fee of twenty dollars, except
 14 for:
- 15 a. A violation of section 39-10-26, 39-10-26.2, 39-10-41, or 39-10-42, a fee of fifty
 16 dollars.
- b. A violation of section 39-10-05 involving failure to yield to a pedestrian or
 subsection 1 of section 39-10-28, a fee of fifty dollars.
- 19 c. A violation of section 39-21-41.2, a fee of twenty-five dollars.
- 20 d. A violation of subsection 1 of section 39-12-02 or section 39-08-23, a fee of one
 21 hundred dollars.
- e. A violation of subdivision d of subsection 1 of section 39-12-04, a fee of one
 hundred dollars.

26	9. 8	For a	a violation of a highway construction zone speed limit under subsection 2 of	
27		sect	ion 39-09-02, a fee of eighty dollars for one through ten miles peran hour over the	
28		post	ed speed; and eighty dollars plus two dollars for each mile per<u>an</u> hour over ten	
29		mile	s per hour over the limit, unless a greater fee would be applicable under this	
30		sect	ion. The fee in this subsection does not apply to a highway construction zone	

- 1 unless individuals engaged in construction are present at the time and place of the
- 2 violation and the posted speed limit sign states "Minimum Fee \$80".
