4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION - DOMESTIC VIOLENCE SHELTER GRANTS. There is appropriated out of any moneys in the strategic investment and improvements fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$2,000,000\$650,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, to the department of commerce for the purpose of providing grants to domestic violence sexual assault organizations as defined in section 14-07.1-01 for constructing, renovating, or purchasing facilities to provide shelter to victims of domestic violence for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017. The department of commerce shall establish guidelines to qualify for a grant under this section. The guidelinesmust include required local matching funds of at least two dollars of nonstate funds for each onedollar of state grant funds for organizations serving communities with populations exceeding-10,000 based on the last decennial census and required local matching funds of at least one dollar of nonstate funds for each one dollar of state grant funds for organizations servingcommunities with populations of 10,000 or fewer based on the last decennial census provide a grant of up to \$400,000 to a qualifying organization serving a community in a non-oil-producing county with a population exceeding 10,000 based on the most recent decennial census. The department shall require three dollars of nonstate funds for each one dollar of the grant funds awarded up to \$400,000. The department shall provide a grant of up to \$250,000 to a qualifying organization serving a community in a non-oil-producing county with a population of 10,000 or fewer based on the most recent decennial census. The department shall require one dollar of nonstate funds for each one dollar of the grant funds awarded of up to \$250,000.

SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE INTENT - FUNDING FROM EARLY DISTRIBUTIONS. It is the intent of the sixty-fourth legislative assembly that funding for grants provided in section 1 of this-Act be considered as part of the funding provided in Senate Bill No. 2103.
