- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 3 of section 61-40-10 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to approval of the state water commission for expansion of the western
- 3 area water supply project.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 3 of section 61-40-10 of the North Dakota Century
6 Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- 7 3. The <u>approval of the</u> state water commission shall approve is required by the authority
- 8 <u>before</u> the planning, location, and water supply contracts of any authority depots,
- 9 laterals, taps, turnouts, and risers for industrial sales for oil and gas exploration and
- 10 production after July 1, 2013. <u>Before the approval by the state water commission, the</u>
- 11 <u>authority must file an application for approval with the state water commission.</u>
- 12 Following receipt of the application, the commission shall give notice of at least
- 13 <u>thirty days to all state water commission permitees providing water for industrial sales</u>
- 14 for oil and gas exploration and production. After notice, the state water commission
- 15 shall hold a hearing to consider public comments and to approve or disapprove the
- 16 <u>application. In making a determination to approve or disapprove the application, the</u>
- 17 <u>commission shall consider the following:</u>
- 18 <u>a.</u> <u>Objections from other providers of industrial water supply:</u>
- 19 <u>b.</u> <u>Private sector capacity to meet the requested demand;</u>
- 20 <u>c.</u> <u>Location and proximity of other private water supply infrastructure in the area;</u>
- 21d.Status of domestic water supply restrictions from the participating authority22members;
- 23 <u>e.</u> <u>Whether the participating member is meeting all domestic water demands;</u>

1	<u>f.</u>	Whether the request follows the depot plan and financing structure approved by
2		the legislative assembly in creating the authority, or is a deviation of that plan;
3	<u>g.</u>	The length of time for which the industrial water supply is requested; and
4	<u>h.</u>	The status of industrial water supply payments to meet obligations in this chapter.
