## **HOUSE BILL NO. 1066**

- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 54-27.2-01 and 54-27.2-02 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to the balance of and transfers to the budget stabilization fund;
- 3 to provide an effective date; and to declare an emergency.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-27.2-01 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 54-27.2-01. Budget stabilization fund.
- 8 The budget stabilization fund is a special fund in the state treasury. The state investment
- 9 board shall supervise investment of the budget stabilization fund in accordance with chapter
- 10 21-10. Any interest or other budget stabilization fund earnings must be deposited in the fund.
- Any amounts provided by law for deposit in the fund and any interest or earnings of the fund
- which would bring the balance in the fund at the end of any fiscal year to an amount greater
- 13 than nine and one-half percent of the current biennial state general fund budget, as finally
- 14 approved by the most recently adjourned special or regular session of the legislative assembly,
- 15 may not be deposited or retained in the fund but must be deposited instead in the state general
- 16 fund.
- 17 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-27.2-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 18 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 19 **54-27.2-02.** Certain general fund revenues to be deposited in the budget stabilization
- 20 fund.
- Notwithstanding any other provision of law except section 54-27.2-01, any amount in the
- state general fund in excess of sixty-five million dollars at the end of any biennium, after
- 23 deducting any amounts that would otherwise be transferred to the general fund under section
- 24 <u>54-27.2-01</u>, must be transferred by the state treasurer to the budget stabilization fund. For

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- 1 purposes of this section, "at the end of any biennium" means after cancellation of unexpended
- 2 appropriations under section 54-44.1-11.
- 3 **SECTION 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.** This Act becomes effective on July 1, 2015.
- 4 **SECTION 4. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
