- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 2-05-11 and 2-05-11.3 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to aircraft registration; and to repeal sections 2-05-11.1 and 2-05-11.2 of
- 3 the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the registration of older aircraft and related
- 4 definitions.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 2-05-11 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended
7 and reenacted as follows:

8 **2-05-11.** Aircraft registration - Fees.

9 The following procedures governing fees and registration apply:

Except as provided in section 2-05-11.3, every aircraft or ultralight vehicle operating
 within this state for more than thirty days must be registered with the aeronautics
 commission for each <u>calendar</u> year in which the aircraft or ultralight vehicle is operated
 within this state, subject to rules adopted by the commission. The commission shall
 charge a fee for each <u>suchannual</u> registration. The following fees apply:

14The fees must be reduced ten percent each year after the initial registration, or if the15aircraft is one year old or older and being registered for the first time, the fees must be16reduced ten percent for each year after the year of manufacture of the aircraft, until-17the fee reaches a figure equal to fifty percent of the original registration fee, which is-18the fee each year thereafter.

- Effective January first of each year, beginning January 1, 2016, the commission may increase annual registration fees by an amount up to the percent change over the past twelve months in the all items consumer price index for all urban consumers that is not seasonally adjusted, as published by the United States bureau of labor statistics.
- 23 <u>3.</u> For aircraft that become based in this state after June thirtieth of any calendar year,
 24 the registration fee is half the applicable annual fee.
- All weights must be based upon the maximum permissible take-off weight, except that
 the weights must be empty weights for all ultralight vehicles which are not certificated
 for maximum permissible take-off weight.
- 3.5.4. The aeronautics commission may charge a reasonable cost of service fee for
 registration of aircraft operated by state agencies, political subdivisions, <u>aviation</u>
 <u>schools operated by state institutions of higher education</u>, or the civil air patrol in lieu
 of the regular registration fee.

3	3 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 2-05-11.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is			
4	4 amended and reenacted as follows:			
5	5 2-05-11.3. Fee for a permanent registration - Issuance of registration decal -			
6	6 Disposition of fee.			
7	<u>1.</u>	The owner of an antique aircraft may permanently register the aircraft by paying the		
8		appropriate fee and submitting the appropriate application to the commission. For		
9		purposes of this section, an antique aircraft is one that was built and originally		
10		federally certified by its manufacturer at least sixty years prior to the submission of the		
11		permanent registration application.		
12	<u>2.</u>	The fee for a permanent registration under section 2-05-11.2 is eighty-fiveone hundred		
13		fifty dollars. Effective January first of each year, beginning January 1, 2016, the		
14		commission may increase the permanent registration fee by an amount up to the		
15		percent change over the past twelve months in the all items consumer price index for		
16		all urban consumers that is not seasonally adjusted, as published by the United States		
17		bureau of labor statistics. The commission shall prepare a distinctive decal denoting		
18		permanent registration under section 2-05-11.2. The fee must be deposited in the		
19		aeronautics commission special fund.		
20	3.	A permanent registration is transferable to a subsequent owner.		
21	SECTION 3. REPEAL. Sections 2-05-11.1 and 2-05-11.2 of the North Dakota Century Code			
22	2 are repealed.
