## **ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1002**

**Appropriations Committee** 

(At the request of the Supreme Court)

- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the judicial branch;
- 2 to provide for the establishment of additional district court judgeships; and to amend and
- 3 reenact sections 27-02-02 and 27-05-03 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to salaries
- 4 of supreme and district court judges.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the judicial branch for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.

28	supreme court, district courts, and judicial conduct commission and disciplinary board, not					
29	otherwise appropriated, pursuant to federal acts and private gifts, grants, and donations for the					
30	purpose as designated in the federal acts or private gifts, grants, and donations for the period					
31	beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.

## 1 SECTION 3. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO 2 SIXTY-FIFTH LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY. The following amounts reflect the one-time funding 3 items approved by the sixty-third legislative assembly for the 2013-15 biennium and the 4 2015-17 one time funding items included in the appropriation in section 1 of this Act: 5 One-Time Funding Description <u>2013-15</u> <u>2015-17</u> 6 Office equipment and furniture \$331,470 \$0 7 516,556 924.460 Information technology equipment 8 90,000 0 Juvenile case management system 9 replacement study 10 0 Disaster recovery planning 95,000 11 139,850 0 Criminal justice information sharing 12 publisher project 13 0 2,171,672 Disaster recovery project 14 Criminal case eFile initiation 0 99,000 15 Total general fund \$1,172,876 \$3,195,132 16 The 2015-17 one-time funding amounts are not a part of the entity's base budget for the 17 2017-19 biennium. The supreme court shall report to the appropriations committees of the 18 sixty-fifth legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium beginning 19 July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017. 20 SECTION 4. TRANSFERS. The director of the office of management and budget and the 21 state treasurer shall make such transfer of funds between line items of appropriation for the 22 judicial branch of government as may be requested by the supreme court upon a finding by the 23 court that the nature of the duties of the court and its staff requires the transfers to carry on 24 properly the functions of the judicial branch of government. 25 SECTION 5. DISTRICT JUDGES. The appropriation provided in subdivision 2 of section 1 26 of this Act provides for two additional district court judges in the south central judicial district, 27 one additional district court judge in the southwest judicial district, and one additional district 28 court judge in the northwest judicial district to be assigned pursuant to section 10 of article VI of 29 the Constitution of North Dakota, and to be assigned to chambers by the supreme court. Within 30 thirty days after the effective date of this Act, the judgeship vacancies created by this section

must be filled in accordance with section 13 of article VI of the Constitution of North Dakota. In

- 1 accordance with section 9 and 13 of article VI of the Constitution of North Dakota, each judge
- 2 appointed to fill a vacancy created by this section continues in office until the next general
- 3 election immediately following two years of service after the appointment. The individual then
- 4 elected holds office for the remainder of the term and until a successor is elected and duly
- 5 qualified.
- 6 **SECTION 6. AMENDMENT.** Section 27-02-02 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 7 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 8 27-02-02. Salaries of justices of supreme court.
- The annual salary of each justice of the supreme court is one hundred forty-three fifty-two
- thousand sixfour hundred eighty-fivethirty-six dollars through June 30, 20142016, and one
- 11 hundred forty-seven thousand nine hundred ninety-six dollars thereafter. The chief
- 12 justice of the supreme court is entitled to receive an additional four thousand onethree hundred
- 13 twenty-sevenseventy-seven dollars per annum through June 30, 20142016, and four thousand
- 14 twofive hundred fiftyeight dollars per annum thereafter.
- 15 **SECTION 7. AMENDMENT.** Section 27-05-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 16 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 17 27-05-03. Salaries and expenses of district judges.
- The annual salary of each district judge is one hundred thirty-onethirty-nine thousand six
- 19 hundred sixty-oneseventy-nine dollars through June 30, 20142016, and one hundred thirty-
- 20 <u>fiveforty-three</u> thousand <u>sixeight</u> hundred <u>elevensixty-nine</u> dollars thereafter. Each district judge
- 21 is entitled to travel expenses, including mileage and subsistence while engaged in the
- 22 discharge of official duties outside the city in which the judge's chambers are located. The
- 23 salary and expenses are payable monthly in the manner provided by law. A presiding judge of a
- 24 judicial district is entitled to receive an additional threefour thousand eight hundred threethirty-
- 25 <u>five</u> dollars per annum through June 30, 20142016, and threefour thousand nineone hundred
- 26 seventeen fifty-six dollars thereafter.
