3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4	SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION	The funds	provided in this s	section,	or so much of the funds
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- 5 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state
- 6 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to the state fair association for the purpose of defraying
- 7 the expenses of the state fair association, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending
- 8 June 30, 2017, as follows:

1 sixty-fifth legislative assembly on the use of the one-time funding for the biennium beginning 2 July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017. 3 SECTION 3. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR OF 4 STATE PROPERTY. During the 2015-16 interim, the legislative management shall consider 5 studying the maintenance and repair of state property and the source of funds to be used for 6 maintenance and repair costs. The study must review current processes being used by state 7 agencies to identify and address maintenance and repairs of state property and the 8 appropriateness of the source of funds being used for these maintenance and repair projects. 9 The legislative management shall report its findings and recommendations, together with any 10 legislation required to implement the recommendations, to the sixty-fifth legislative assembly. 11 SECTION 4. EMERGENCY. The capital assets line item in section 1 of this Act is declared 12 to be an emergency measure.
