BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds 7 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 8 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, to the office of the governor for the purpose of defraying 9 the expenses of the office of the governor, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending 10 June 30, 2017, as follows:

The office of the governor shall report to the appropriations committees of 8 the sixty-fifth legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium 9 beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017. 10 SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - GOVERNOR'S OFFICE - LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT 11 **REPORT.** In addition to the amounts appropriated to the governor's office in section 1 of this 12 Act, there is appropriated to the governor's office, any additional income from federal or other 13 funds which may become available to the governor's office, for the biennium beginning July 1, 14 2015, and ending June 30, 2017. Any funds received under this section must be used for the 15 specific purpose intended for the funds or transferred to the appropriate state agency or 16 institution. Upon the receipt of funds under this section, the governor's office shall provide a 17 report to the legislative management regarding the source, amount, and purpose of the funds 18 received. 19 **SECTION 4. AMENDMENT.** Section 54-07-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is 20 amended and reenacted as follows: 21 54-07-04. Salary of governor. 22 The annual salary of the governor is one hundred twenty one thousand six hundred-23 eighty-one dollars through June 30, 2014, and one hundred twenty-five thousand three hundred 24 thirty-one one hundred twenty-nine thousand ninety-one dollars through June 30, 2016, and one 25 <u>hundred thirty-two thousand nine hundred sixty-four</u> dollars thereafter. 26 SECTION 5. AMENDMENT. Section 54-08-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is 27 amended and reenacted as follows: 28 54-08-03. Salary of lieutenant governor. 29 The annual salary of the lieutenant governor is ninety-four thousand four hundred sixty-two-30 dollars through June 30, 2014, and ninety-seven thousand two hundred ninety-sixone hundred

- 1 thousand two hundred fifteen dollars through June 30, 2016, and one hundred three thousand
