5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the agriculture commissioner for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017, as follows:

SECTION 2. ONE-TIME FUNDING - EFFECT ON BASE BUDGET - REPORT TO

SIXTY-FIFTH LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY. The following amounts reflect the 2015-17 one-time funding items included in the appropriation in section 1 of this Act:

The 2015-17 one-time funding amounts are not a part of the entity's base budget for the 2017-19 biennium. The agriculture commissioner shall report to the appropriations committees of the sixty-fifth legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium

beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.

SECTION 3. TRANSFER - ENVIRONMENT AND RANGELAND PROTECTION FUND -

MINOR USE PESTICIDE FUND. The agriculture commissioner shall transfer \$325,000 from the environment and rangeland protection fund to the minor use pesticide fund during the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.

SECTION 4. ESTIMATED INCOME - ENVIRONMENT AND RANGELAND PROTECTION

FUND. The estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$6,414,476\$6,403,714, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, from the environment and rangeland protection fund for the purpose of defraying the expenses of various department of agriculture programs, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.

SECTION 5. ESTIMATED INCOME - GAME AND FISH FUND. The estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$499,585, or so much of the sum as may be

1 necessary, from the game and fish department operating fund for the purpose of defraying the 2 expenses of various department of agriculture programs, for the biennium beginning July 1, 3 2015, and ending June 30, 2017. 4 SECTION 6. ESTIMATED INCOME - STATE WATER COMMISSION - TRANSFER. The 5 estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$250,000 which the state 6 water commission shall transfer to the agriculture commissioner for the wildlife services 7 program, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017. 8 SECTION 7. WATERBANK PROGRAM - MATCHING FUNDS. The salaries and wages line 9 item in section 1 of this Act includes \$50,000 from the general fund for matching funds for the 10 North Dakota outdoor heritage fund grant provided for the waterbank program. 11 SECTION 8. AMENDMENT. Section 4-01-21 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended 12 and reenacted as follows: 13 4-01-21. Salary of agriculture commissioner. 14 The annual salary of the agriculture commissioner is ninety-nine thousand four hundred-15 thirty-five dollars through June 30, 2014, and one hundred two thousand four hundred 16 eighteenone hundred five thousand four hundred ninety-one dollars through June 30, 2016, and 17 one hundred eight thousand six hundred fifty-six dollars thereafter. 18 SECTION 9. EMERGENCY. The sum of \$100,000 of federal funds included in the state 19 board of animal health line item in section 1 of this Act is declared to be an emergency 20 measure.
