- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the office of the
- 2 adjutant general; to provide for transfers; to provide exemptions; and to declare an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the office of the adjutant general for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017 as follows:

22 2017-19 biennium. The adjutant general shall report to the appropriations committees of the sixty-fifth legislative assembly on the use of this one-time funding for the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.

SECTION 3. APPROPRIATION - STATE DISASTER RELIEF FUND. Notwithstanding section 37-17.1-27, there is appropriated out of any moneys in the state disaster relief fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, the sum of \$5,000,000, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, subject to emergency commission approval, to the adjutant general for the purposes of providing the required state share of funding for defraying the expenses associated with presidentially declared disasters, for the period beginning with the effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 2017.

1 SECTION 4. VETERANS' CEMETERY MAINTENANCE FUND - APPROPRIATION. In 2 addition to the amount appropriated to the adjutant general in the veterans' cemetery line item 3 in subdivision 1 of section 1 of this Act, there is appropriated any additional funds which are 4 received and deposited in the veterans' cemetery maintenance fund pursuant to sections 5 37-03-14 and 39-04-10.10 for the operation of the North Dakota veterans' cemetery for the 6 biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017. 7 SECTION 5. MAINTENANCE AND REPAIRS - TRANSFERS. The adjutant general may 8 transfer to the operating expenses and capital assets line items contained in section 1 of this 9 Act up to the sum of \$500,000 from the various other line items contained in section 1 of this 10 Act, as determined necessary by the adjutant general to provide for the maintenance and repair 11 of state-owned armories in this state during the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending 12 June 30, 2017. Any amounts transferred pursuant to this section must be reported to the 13 director of the office of management and budget. 14 SECTION 6. FUNDING TRANSFERS - STATE EMPLOYEE COMPENSATION 15 **ADJUSTMENTS - EXCEPTION.** Notwithstanding section 54-16-04, the adjutant general may 16 transfer appropriation authority between line items within each subdivision of section 1 of this 17 Act and between subdivisions within section 1 of this Act, as it relates to state employee 18 compensation increases authorized by the sixty-fourth legislative assembly, for the biennium 19 beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017. The adjutant general shall notify the office of 20 management and budget of any transfer made under this section. 21 SECTION 7. EXEMPTION. The amount appropriated in the radio communications line for 22 statewide seamless base map, state radio tower package, computer-aided dispatch upgrade, 23 and the voice incident recorder, in subdivision 2 of section 1 of chapter 16 of the 2013 Session 24 Laws is not subject to section 54-44.1-11 and any unexpended funds are available for 25 completing these projects during the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 26 2017. 27 **SECTION 8. EXEMPTION.** The amount appropriated in the operating expenses line for the 28 computer-aided dispatch upgrade and the disaster coordination contract in subdivision 2 of 29 section 1 of chapter 16 of the 2013 Session Laws is not subject to section 54-44.1-11 and any 30 unexpended funds are available for these purposes during the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, 31 and ending June 30, 2017.

1 **SECTION 9. EXEMPTION.** The amount appropriated in the operating expenses line for the 2 writing, publishing, and distribution of a record of all North Dakota veterans, including a record 3 of all North Dakotans killed in action and missing in action since statehood, subdivision 1 of 4 section 1 of chapter 16 of the 2013 Session Laws is not subject to 54-44.1-11 and any 5 unexpended funds are available for these purposes during the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, 6 and ending June 30, 2017. 7 **SECTION 10. EXEMPTION.** The amount appropriated in the tuition, recruiting, and 8 retention line item in subdivision 1 of section 1 of chapter 16 of the 2013 Session Laws is not 9 subject to section 54-44.1-11, and any unexpended funds from this appropriation may be used 10 to provide tuition assistance, recruiting and retention incentives to eligible members of the North 11 Dakota national guard during the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017. 12 **SECTION 11. EXEMPTION.** The amount appropriated in the tuition, recruiting, and 13 retention line item in section 3 of chapter 16 of the 2013 Session Laws is not subject to section 14 54-44.1-11 and any unexpended funds from this appropriation may be used to provide tuition 15 assistance to eligible members of the North Dakota national guard, during the biennium 16 beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017, contingent upon the adjutant general 17 certifying to the office of management and budget that the national guard has received a new 18 assignment in association with the Grand Forks air force base. 19 **SECTION 12. EXEMPTION.** Any amounts carried over pursuant to section 9 of chapter 16 20 of the 2013 Session Laws that is unexpended as of June 30, 2015 is not subject to section 21 54-44.1-11 and is available for payment of adjusted compensation to veterans. Any unexpended 22 funds from this appropriation must be transferred to the veterans' cemetery trust fund during the 23 biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30, 2017. 24 SECTION 13. EXEMPTION. Any amounts carried over in the radio communications line for 25 the state radio tower package pursuant to section 10 of chapter 16 of the 2013 Session Laws 26 that is unexpended as of June 30, 2015, is not subject to section 54-44.1-11. Any unexpended 27 funds are available for state radio tower package costs during the biennium beginning July 1, 28 2015, and ending June 30, 2017. 29 SECTION 14. EXEMPTION. Any amounts carried over in the disaster costs line for flood 30 relief or disaster mitigation projects in incorporated cities, and grants to political subdivisions for 31 amounts required to match federal dollars on road grade raising projects and federal

- 1 emergency relief funding pursuant to section 11 of chapter 16 of the 2013 Session Laws that is
- 2 unexpended as of June 30, 2015, is not subject to section 54-44.1-11. Any unexpended funds
- 3 from this appropriation are available for these purposes during the biennium beginning July 1,
- 4 2015, and ending June 30, 2017.
- 5 **SECTION 15. EXEMPTION.** Any amounts carried over in the disaster costs line for grants
- 6 to cities and counties for flood-impacted housing rehabilitation pursuant to section 12 of
- 7 chapter 16 of the 2013 Session Laws that is unexpended as of June 30, 2015, is not subject to
- 8 section 54-44.1-11. Any unexpended funds from this appropriation are available for these
- 9 purposes during the biennium beginning July 1, 2015, and ending June 30,2017.
- 10 **SECTION 16. EMERGENCY.** Funding of \$500,000 from the general fund in the grants line
- item in subdivision 1 of section 1 of this Act, relating to the veterans' bonus program, funding of
- 12 \$386,000 from the general fund in the radio communications line item in subdivision 2 of
- section 1 of this Act, relating to next generation 911, funding of \$209,280 from the general fund
- in the operating line item in subdivision 2 of section 1 of this Act, relating to next generation 911
- maintenance, and funding of \$382,000 from the general fund in the operating line item in
- 16 subdivision 2 of section 1 of this Act relating to statewide base map maintenance, are declared
- 17 to be an emergency measure.
