11	Wł	nether the bond is issued by the state bonding fund or by a surety company, it shall

13	<u> </u>	Faithfully discharge all the duties of the office.
14	<u> 2. <u>b.</u></u>	Account annually to the judge of the district court for all estates and property
15		under the public administrator's official control and care, or whenever required so-
16		to do by the judge.
17	<u> </u>	Turn over to the successor in office all property and estates in the public
18		administrator's official care and control, and truly account for the same.
19	<u> 4. <u>d.</u></u>	Turn over all property and estates in the public administrator's official care and
20		control to any other administrator, executor, or guardian designated by the judge-
21		of the district court, and truly account for the same.
22	<u> </u>	Perform such other acts and duties properly relating to the office as may be
23		ordered by the district judge.

1	The bond shall be approved and endorsed as provided for administrators and	
2	executors.	
3	<u>2. The county in which a noncorporate public administrator is appointed under this</u>	
4	chapter shall provide coverage or legal representation, or both, through the North	
5	Dakota insurance reserve fund or a similar entity to defend a claim against the public	
6	administrator based on services provided while acting within the administrator's scope	
7	of authority in accordance with the appointment and this chapter.	
8	SECTION 1. A new section to chapter 11-21 of the North Dakota Century Code is created	
9	and enacted as follows:	
10	Liability coverage for public administrators.	
11	The county in which a noncorporate public administrator is appointed must provide liability	
12	risk coverage for services provided by that public administrator while acting within the role of	
13	public administrator.	
14	SECTION 2. EXPIRATION DATE. This Act is effective through July 31, 2017, and after that	
15	date is ineffective.
