1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 54-44.1-11 of the North Dakota Century Code,

2 relating to the cancellation of unexpended appropriations; and to declare an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 54-44.1-11 of the North Dakota Century Code is
amended and reenacted as follows:

54-44.1-11. (Effective through July 31, 2017) Office of management and budget to cancel unexpended appropriations - When they may continue.

8 Except as otherwise provided by law, the office of management and budget, thirty days after 9 the close of each biennial period, shall cancel all unexpended appropriations or balances of 10 appropriations after the expiration of the biennial period during which they became available 11 under the law. Unexpended appropriations for the state historical society are not subject to this 12 section and the state historical society shall report on the amounts and uses of funds carried 13 over from one biennium to the next to the appropriations committees of the next subsequent-14 legislative assembly. Unexpended appropriations for the North Dakota university system are not 15 subject to this section and the North Dakota university system shall report on the amounts and 16 uses of funds carried over from one biennium to the next to subsequent the appropriations 17 committees of the next legislative assembly. The Upon request, the majority leaders of the 18 senate and house of representatives of the legislative assembly and the chairmen of the 19 appropriations committees of the senate and house of representatives of the legislative 20 assembly with the office of the budget may, subject to approval by at least three of the four 21 legislative members, continue appropriations or balances in force for not more than two years 22 after the expiration of the biennial period during which they became available upon 23 recommendation of the director of the budget for:

24 1. New construction projects.

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1 2. Major repair or improvement projects. 2 3. Purchases of new equipment costing more than ten thousand dollars per unit if it was 3 ordered during the first twelve months of the biennium in which the funds were 4 appropriated. 5 4. The purchase of land by the state on a "contract for deed" purchase if the total 6 purchase price is within the authorized appropriation. 7 5. Purchases by the department of transportation of roadway maintenance equipment 8 costing more than ten thousand dollars per unit if the equipment was ordered during 9 the first twenty-one months of the biennium in which the funds were appropriated. 10 6. Authorized ongoing information technology projects. 11 The office of management and budget shall provide the appropriation continuation requests to 12 the legislative council a minimum of two weeks prior to the meeting at which the requests are 13 considered. 14 (Effective after July 31, 2017) Office of management and budget to cancel 15 unexpended appropriations - When they may continue. The office of management and 16 budget, thirty days after the close of each biennial period, shall cancel all unexpended 17 appropriations or balances of appropriations after the expiration of the biennial period during 18 which they became available under the law. Unexpended appropriations for the state historical 19 society are not subject to this section and the state historical society shall report on the amounts 20 and uses of funds carried over from one biennium to the next to the appropriations committees 21 of the next subsequent legislative assembly. The Upon request, the majority leaders of the 22 senate and house of representatives of the legislative assembly and the chairmen of the 23 appropriations committees of the senate and house of representatives of the legislative 24 assembly with the office of the budget may, subject to approval by at least three of the four 25 legislative members, continue appropriations or balances in force for not more than two years 26 after the expiration of the biennial period during which they became available upon 27 recommendation of the director of the budget for: 28 New construction projects. 1. 29 2. Major repair or improvement projects.

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- Purchases of new equipment costing more than ten thousand dollars per unit if it was
 ordered during the first twelve months of the biennium in which the funds were
 appropriated.
 The purchase of land by the state on a "contract for deed" purchase if the total
 purchase price is within the authorized appropriation.
- 6 5. Purchases by the department of transportation of roadway maintenance equipment
 7 costing more than ten thousand dollars per unit if the equipment was ordered during
- 8 the first twenty-one months of the biennium in which the funds were appropriated.
- 9 6. Authorized ongoing information technology projects.
- 10 The office of management and budget shall provide the appropriation continuation requests to
- 11 the legislative council a minimum of two weeks prior to the meeting at which the requests are
- 12 <u>considered.</u>
- 13 **SECTION 2. EMERGENCY.** This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
