- 1 A BILL for an Act to to create and enact a new section to chapter 54-17 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to an inmate program to construct homes for low-income home buyers.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 54-17 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
- 6 <u>Inmate housing construction program.</u>
- 7 <u>1. The industrial commission and the department of corrections and rehabilitation shall</u>
- 8 <u>collaborate to establish a program through which inmates are provided housing</u>
- 9 <u>construction vocational skills through the construction of homes that are made</u>
- 10 <u>available for sale to low-income home buyers.</u>
- 11 <u>2.</u> <u>The industrial commission:</u>

- a. May appoint an advisory board to assist with this program, which may include
 private and public membership.
- b. May offer home purchase financing or loan guarantees through the Bank of North
 Dakota.
 - c. May administer the program through the housing finance agency.
- d. Shall establish home buyer qualifications, which must include provisions:
- 18 (1) Setting household income limits.
- 19 (2) Requiring the program home be used as the home buyer's sole residence.
- 20 (3) Requiring the program home to be placed within the state.
- 21 <u>3. The department of corrections and rehabilitation:</u>
- a. May add this program to the program of modified workers' compensation
- 23 <u>coverage established under chapter 65-06.2.</u>
- b. May employ inmates under this program in accordance with chapter 12-48.
