- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 15.1-37-05, 15.1-37-06, and 15.1-37-08 of the
- 2 North Dakota Century Code, relating to early childhood education programs, providers, grants,
- 3 and data collection.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-37-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is

6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7	15.1	-37-05. Early childhood education providers - Coalition - Eligibility.				
8	1.	The superintendent of a school district shall invite all public and private providers of				
9		early childhood education services within the district to meet, in order to:				
10		a. Initiate the identification of all available options for cost-effectively maximizing the				
11		provision of early childhood education services within the district;				
12		b. Address the coordinated utilization of facilities, personnel, and transportation, for				
13		the provision of early childhood education services within the district; and				
14		c. (1) Form a coalition of early childhood education service providers; and				
15		(2) Provide for the selection of a coalition governing board.				
16	2.	The board of the school district in which the coalition of service providers is located				
17		shall provide advice and guidance to the coalition in all matters pertaining to this				
18		section through section 15.1-37-08.				
19	3.	Any early childhood service provider who agrees to participate in the coalition or on its				
20		governing board may submit an application to the departmentsuperintendent of				
21		commercepublic instruction for a grant under this section, provided the governing				
22		board certifies to the department thatsuperintendent the provider:				
23		a. Is a participating member in the coalition or on the governing board.				
24		b. Operates an early childhood education program that:				

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1			(1)	Is approved in accordance with section 15.1-37-01; and				
2			(2)	Incorporates within its curriculum at least ten hours of research-based				
3				parental involvement.				
4		C.	Has	documented the provider's willingness to admit children of all learning				
5			abili	ties into the early childhood education program.				
6	SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-37-06 of the North Dakota Century Code is							
7	amend	amended and reenacted as follows:						
8	15.1-37-06. Receipt and distribution of grants - Notification.							
9	1.	<u>a.</u>	The	departmentsuperintendent of commercepublic instruction shall receive				
10			appl	lications for and distribute grants under this section to eligible members,				
11			inclu	uding governing board members, of a consortium formed in accordance with				
12			sect	ion 15.1-37-05, in the amount of two thousand dollars for each child enrolled				
13			in a	program of early childhood education, if the child is eligible for free lunches				
14			unde	er the Richard B. Russell National School Lunch Act [42 U.S.C. 1751, et				
15			seq.], and one thousand dollars for each child enrolled in a program of early				
16			child	shood education, if the child is eligible for reduced lunches under the Richard				
17			B. R	Russell National School Lunch Act [42 U.S.C. 1751, et seq.], provided:				
18		a.	<u>(1)</u>	The child is a resident of this state; and				
19		b.	<u>(2)</u>	The child has reached four years of age before August first in the year of				
20				enrollment; and				
21			<u>(3)</u>	The program has a duration of at least four hundred hours over a period of				
22				at least thirty-two consecutive weeks.				
23		<u>b.</u>	<u>A ch</u>	ild enrolled in a federally funded head start program may not be counted for				
24			the p	the purpose of determining grant eligibility under this section.				
25	2.	a.	Onc	e each calendar quarter, at the time and in the manner required by the				
26			depa	artmentsuperintendent of commercepublic instruction, any provider receiving				
27			a gra	ant under this section shall forward to the parent of each child receiving				
28			services a notice indicating the total amount of the grant that was awarded to the					
29			provider for the quarter, the pro rata amount attributable to the parent's child, and					
30			the source of the grant. The departmentsuperintendent of commercepublic					
31			<u>instr</u>	ruction shall standardize the notification required by this subdivision.				

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1	b. If a provider fails to meet the notification requirements of this subsection,	the
2	departmentsuperintendent of commercepublic instruction shall reduce the	Э
3	amount of the provider's next grant payment by fifty percent. If a provider	fails to
4	meet the notification requirements of this section a second time, the	
5	departmentsuperintendent of commercepublic instruction shall determine	that the
6	provider is ineligible to participate in the grant program for a period of one	e year.
7	SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-37-08 of the North Dakota Century Code	is
8	amended and reenacted as follows:	
9	15.1-37-08. Data collection - Requirements.	
10	The superintendent of public instruction, with the advice and consent of the departm	ent of
11	commerce, shall implement a uniform system for the accounting, budgeting, and reporti	ng of
12	data by any early childhood education provider to whom or to which grants are distribute	ed in
13	accordance with section 15.1-37-06. Grants may be withheld or forfeited, in whole or in	part, if
14	information required in accordance with this section is not submitted at the time or in the	;
15	manner requested by the superintendent.
