1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new subdivision to subsection 2 of section 12-60-24
2 and a new subsection to section 50-12-03.2 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to
3 criminal history record checks requested by the department of commerce for volunteers
4 providing mentoring and youth engagement services to at-risk youth and homeless young
5 adults through the department.

6 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:**

7 **SECTION 1.** A new subdivision to subsection 2 of section 12-60-24 of the North Dakota
8 Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

9 The department of commerce for volunteers providing mentoring and youth
10 engagement services to at-risk youth and homeless young adults through
11 nonprofit organizations under chapter 50-12.

12 **SECTION 2.** A new subsection to section 50-12-03.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is
13 created and enacted as follows:

14 The child-placing agency is responsible for all fees associated with a criminal history
15 record investigation requested under section 1 of this Act for a volunteer providing
16 mentoring and youth engagement services to at-risk youth and homeless young
17 adults.
