BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

8	SECTION 1. A new subdivision to subsection 2 of section 12-60-24 of the North Dakota
9	Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
10	The department of commerce for volunteers providing mentoring and youth
11	engagement services to at-risk youth and homeless young adults through
12	nonprofit organizations under chapter 50-12.
13	SECTION 2. A new subsection to section 50-12-03.2 of the North Dakota Century Code is
14	created and enacted as follows:
15	The child-placing agency is responsible for all fees associated with a criminal history
16	record investigation requested under section 1 of this Act for a volunteer providing
17	mentoring and youth engagement services to at-risk youth and homeless young
18	adults.
19	SECTION 2. A new subdivision to subsection 2 of section 12-60-24 of the North Dakota
20	Century Code is created and enacted as follows:
21	The state court administrator for a guardian ad litem who provides direct services
22	to youth.
