## FIRST ENGROSSMENT with Senate Amendments **ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1023**

- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the public employees
- 2 retirement system; to provide for a transfer; to create and enact a new subsection to section
- 3 54-02-04 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to public employees retirement system
- 4 payments; to provide for a legislative management study; and to provide for legislative intent.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

6 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds 7 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys from special funds derived from 8 income to the public employees retirement system for the purpose of defraying the expenses of 9 the public employees retirement system, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending 10 June 30, 2019, as follows:

SECTION 2. HEALTH INSURANCE INCREASE. The salaries and wages line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$95,431 from other funds for increases in employee health insurance premiums from \$1,130 to \$1,241 per month.
