- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 39-29-10 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the minimum age required to operate an off-highway vehicle.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 39-29-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **39-29-10. Operation by persons under age sixteenindividuals - Minimum age**.

- 7 Except as otherwise provided in this section, an
- 8 <u>1.</u> <u>An</u> individual under sixteenten years of age who is not in possession of a valid-
- 9 operator's license or permit to operate an off-highway vehicle may not, except upon-
- 10 the lands of the individual's parent or guardian or as a participant in an organized
- 11 sporting event that involves the use of off-highway vehicles, operate an off-highway-
- 12 vehicle operate an off-highway vehicle unless the individual operates the off-highway
- 13 <u>vehicle on private land. An individual ten or eleven years of age may not operate an</u>
- 14 off-highway vehicle unless the individual operates the off-highway vehicle on private_
- 15 land or the individual is in the presence of a parent or guardian pursuant to chapter
- 16 <u>30.1-27, has completed an off-highway safety training course as prescribed by the</u>
- 17 director of the parks and recreation department pursuant to chapter 28-32, and has
- 18 received the appropriate off-highway safety certificate issued by the director of the
- 19 <u>parks and recreation department</u>.
- 20 <u>2.</u> An individual at least twelve years of age <u>and over may not</u> operate an off-highway
 21 vehicle if<u>unless</u> the individual is in possession of a valid driver's license, operates the
 22 <u>off-highway vehicle on private land, or</u> has completed an off-highway vehicle safety
 23 training course prescribed by the director of the parks and recreation department
- 24 <u>pursuant to chapter 28-32</u> and has received the appropriate off-highway vehicle safety

2		transportation.
3	<u>3.</u>	The failure of an operator to exhibit an off-highway vehicle safety certificate on
4		demand to any official authorized to enforce this chapter is presumptive evidence that
5		that person does not hold a certificate.
6	<u>4.</u>	Fees collected from eachan individual receiving certification must be deposited in the
7		off-highway vehicle trail tax fund for off-highway vehicle safety education and training
8		programs.
