1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section to chapter 26.1-40 of the North Dakota

2 <u>Century Code, relating to duplicate motor vehicle insurance coverage; and</u> to amend and

3 reenact subsection 4 of section 26.1-39-11, section 26.1-39-20, and subsection 5 of section

4 26.1-40-01<del>, and section 26.1-40-09</del> of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to termination of

5 insurance and duplicate property insurance coverage.

## 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

7 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 4 of section 26.1-39-11 of the North Dakota 8 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 9 4. "Termination" means either a cancellation or nonrenewal of property insurance 10 coverage in whole or in part by the insurer. A cancellationCancellation occurs during 11 the policy term. A nonrenewal Nonrenewal occurs at the end of the policy term as set 12 forth in subsection 3. For purposes of sections 26.1-39-10 through 26.1-39-21, the 13 transfer of a policy between companies within the same insurance holding company 14 system is not a termination. Requiring a reasonable deductible, reasonable changes in 15 the amount of insurance, or reasonable reductions in policy limits or coverage is not 16 considered a termination if the requirements are directly related to the hazard involved 17 and are made on the renewal date for the policy. 18 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 26.1-39-20 of the North Dakota Century Code is 19 amended and reenacted as follows: 20 26.1-39-20. Duplicate coverage. 21 If an insured obtains a replacement policy that provides providing equal or more extensive 22 coverage for anya property covered in both policies, the first insurer's coverage of thethat 23 property may be terminated either by cancellation or nonrenewal. 1	the effective date of the second policy providing duplicate replacement coverage. Upon
2	termination, the insured is entitled to a refund of the premium.
3	SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Subsection 5 of section 26.1-40-01 of the North Dakota
4	Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
5	5. "Termination" means either a cancellation or nonrenewal of automobile insurance
6	coverage in whole or in part by the insurer. A cancellationCancellation occurs during
7	the policy term. A nonrenewalNonrenewal occurs at the end of the policy term. An
8	insurer's substitution of insurance upon renewal which results in substantially
9	equivalent coverage is not a termination. The transfer of a policy between companies
10	within the same insurance holding company system is not a termination.
11	- SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 26.1-40-09 of the North Dakota Century Code is
12	amended and reenacted as follows:
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15	26.1-40-12, termination of any coverage under the policy eitherby the insurer by cancellation or-
16	nonrenewal is effective on the effective date of any other policy providing similar coverage on
17	the same motor vehicle or any replacement of the motor vehicle.
18	SECTION 4. A new section to chapter 26.1-40 of the North Dakota Century Code is created
19	and enacted as follows:
20	Duplicate coverage.
21	If an insured obtains a replacement policy providing equal or more extensive coverage for a
22	motor vehicle covered in both policies, the first insurer's coverage of that motor vehicle may be
23	terminated either by cancellation or nonrenewal. The termination is effective on the effective
24	date of the second policy providing duplicate replacement coverage. Upon termination, the
25	insured is entitled to a refund of the premium.
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
