SB2293 is to repeal current language and licensure levels that are not consistent with mobility and portability. Defines scope of practice, and terms associated with the practice of social work /public protection. The NDBSWE to obtain reimbursement for costs acquired during a disciplinary hearing.

Section 6 of SB2293 would entitle board members to be compensated for their time, on a quarterly basis which would total approximately 1200.00 per meeting along with all reasonable and necessary expense. The NDBSWE revenue would be used for this.

Section 11 of SB2293 requires the NDBSWE to reissue licenses to those who are licensed social workers with the correct updated licensure levels designations reflected in the bill. This cost would be taken from NDBSWE revenue. This will impact entities that employ social workers only to the extent that as job descriptions will need to be updated to reflect the new licensure designation levels. The cost to the board to send out 2400 new licenses with updated licensure designation will approximately cost \$3,200.00.

Agencies with employees who have a license will need to update the licensure designations in job descriptions. The cost here is dependent on the number of social workers employed at each agency.

Section 11 of SB 2293 Requires that employers across the state update licensure designations levels in job descriptions. Cost varies on number of licensed social workers in each place of employment.

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
