3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 39-06-19 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

6 **39-06-19. Expiration of license - Renewal.**

- Every operator's license issued under this chapter or chapter 39-06.2 expires and is
 renewed according to this section.

- 10a.Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, the expiration date of a11noncommercial operator's license for an individual whose birth occurred in a year12ending in an odd numeral is twelve midnight on the anniversary of the birthday in13the thirdfourth subsequent year ending in an odd numeral, except for an-14individual who, at the time of renewal, is seventy eight years of age or older is-
- twelve midnight on the anniversary of the birthday in the second subsequent year ending in an odd numeral.
- b. For an individual who, at the time of renewal is between sixty-five years of age
 and seventy-eight years of age, the expiration date is twelve midnight on the
 anniversary of the birthday in the third subsequent year ending in an odd
 numeral.
- c. For an individual who, at the time of renewal is seventy-eight years of age or
 older, the expiration date is twelve midnight on the anniversary of the birthday in
 the second subsequent year ending in an odd numeral.

- 15.6.An applicant for renewal must present the application with the fee for renewal of2license to the director not before ten months before the expiration date of the3operator's license. The director may require an examination of an applicant as upon4an original application. The director may require an applicant for renewal or a5substitute to provide a social security card and proof of residence address. The6director may not issue a distinguishing number that is, contains, can be converted to,7or is an encrypted version of the applicant's social security number.
- 6.7. The director may not renew an operator's license if the license has been suspended
 under section 14-08.1-07. Upon the recommendation of the court, the director may
 issue a temporary permit to the licensee under section 39-06.1-11 if the temporary
 permit is necessary for the licensee to work and the court has determined the licensee
 is making a good-faith effort to comply with the child support order.
- 7.8. An applicant for renewal of an operator's license must provide a certificate of
 examination from the driver licensing or examining authorities or a statement as to the
 corrected and uncorrected vision of the applicant from a licensed physician or an
 optometrist. The director shall provide visual examination equipment at each location
 where a license may be renewed.
- 8.9. An individual submitting an application and the fee for renewal of license one year or
 more after the expiration of a license, except an applicant whose military service has
 terminated less than thirty days prior to the application, must be treated as an initial
 applicant.
- SECTION 2. APPLICATION. The changes in the length of an operator's license in section 1
 of this Act apply upon the expiration of a current operator's license.
