

HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3012

1 A concurrent resolution urging the North Dakota High School Activities Association to expand
2 the classification of schools in the state for boys and girls basketball to include a third tier and to
3 rename the tiers Class AAA, Class AA, and Class A and to expand athletic offerings to include
4 six-man football.

5 **WHEREAS**, under the classification system used by the North Dakota High School
6 Activities Association, Class A schools consist of all member high schools with a total enrollment
7 of 325 students or more and Class B schools consist of all member high schools with a total
8 enrollment of 324 students or fewer; and

9 **WHEREAS**, many schools in the state have enrollments that fall far below the enrollment
10 threshold for Class B schools; and

11 **WHEREAS**, many schools with smaller enrollments find it difficult to compete with the larger
12 counterparts in activities offered by the North Dakota High School Activities Association; and

13 **WHEREAS**, some school cooperatives require students to travel more than 40 miles one
14 way for football; and

15 **WHEREAS**, offering a third tier of classification and six-man football would allow many
16 smaller high schools to participate in activities offered by the North Dakota High School
17 Activities Association at a more competitive level;

18 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF**
19 **NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

20 That the Sixty-fifth Legislative Assembly urges the North Dakota High School Activities
21 Association to expand the classification of schools in the state for boys and girls basketball to
22 include a third tier and to rename the tiers Class AAA, Class AA, and Class A and to expand
23 athletic offerings to include six-man football; and

- 2 to each member of the executive staff and board of directors of the North Dakota High School
- 3 Activities Association.
