1	A concurrent resolution requesting the Legislative Management to consider studying the
2	desirability of moving city and other local elections from the primary election in June in
3	even-numbered years to the general election in November in even-numbered years.
4	WHEREAS, city and other local elections are held on the second Tuesday in June in each
5	even-numbered year; and
6	WHEREAS, primary elections for United States senators, member of the House of
7	Representatives, members of the legislative assembly, elected state officials, judges of the
8	supreme court and district courts, county officers, and county commissioners are held on the
9	second Tuesday in June of every general election year; and
0	WHEREAS, general elections are held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in
11	November of each even-numbered year; and
2	WHEREAS, holding city and other local elections concurrently with primary elections may
13	cause confusion; and
4	WHEREAS, newly elected city commission and city council members take office on the
15	fourth Tuesday in June; and
16	WHEREAS, because city governing bodies must prepare preliminary budgets by
7	September tenth, newly elected city commissioners and city council members have
8	approximately two months after taking office to gain the knowledge necessary to prepare
9	preliminary budgets;
20	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF
21	NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:
22	That the Legislative Management consider studying the desirability of moving city and other
23	local elections from the primary election in June in even-numbered years to the general election
24	in November in even-numbered years; and
