HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 3014

1 A concurrent resolution requesting the Legislative Management to consider studying the various
2 legal notice requirements of all state agencies, the related costs required in state budgets, and
3 potential notification alternatives.

4 **WHEREAS**, the North Dakota Century Code requires numerous state agencies to publish
5 various legal notices; and

6 **WHEREAS**, state agencies spend an estimated \$3,700,000 during each biennium in
7 publishing legal notices; and

8 **WHEREAS**, state leaders are constantly pursuing solutions to be more fiscally responsible;
9 and

10 **WHEREAS**, many forms of alternative and mainstream media are now available to provide
11 legal notices;

12 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF**
13 **NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN:**

14 That the Legislative Management consider studying the various legal notice requirements of
15 all state agencies, the related costs required in state budgets, and potential notification
16 alternatives; and

17 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED**, that the Legislative Management report its findings and
18 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
19 the Sixty-sixth Legislative Assembly.
