1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 15.1-18-07 and 15.1-18-09 of the North-2 Dakota Century Code, relating to the school grades that require elementary or high school-3 teacher qualifications; and to repeal section 15.1-18-08 of the North Dakota Century Code, 4 relating to middle school teacher qualifications.for an Act to create and enact a new section to 5 chapter 15.1-18 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to teacher requirements for 6 prekindergarten and kindergarten; to amend and reenact subdivision a of subsection 1 of 7 section 15.1-07-32 and section 15.1-18-02 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to 8 teacher requirements; and to repeal sections 15.1-18-07, 15.1-18-08, and 15.1-18-09 of the 9 North Dakota Century Code, relating to elementary, middle, and high school teacher qualifications. 10

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

12	SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 15.1-18-07 of the North Dakota Century Code is		
13	amended and reenacted as follows:		
14	15.1-18-07. Elementary school teacher qualifications.		
15	1. In order to teach any grade in an elementary school that offers grades one through six		
16	or in order to teach any grade in an elementary school that offers grades one through-		
17	eight, an individual must be:		
18	a. Licensed to teach by the education standards and practices board or approved to		
19	teach by the education standards and practices board; and		
20	b. (1) Have a major in elementary education; or		
21	(2) Have a major equivalency in elementary education.		
22	2. Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 1, an individual may teach any grade		
23	from one through three in an elementary school provided the individual is:

15.1-18-02. Prekindergarten and kindergarten teacher qualifications -Exceptions requirements.

In order to teach prekindergarten and kindergarten, an individual must be:

- Licensed to teach by the education standards and practices board or approved to teach by the education standards and practices board; and
- 2. Have a major in elementary education and a kindergarten endorsement;

17		a. A major in elementary education; or				
18		b. A major equivalency in elementary education.				
19	2.	An individual who is licensed to teach by the education standards and practices	board			
20		or approved to teach by the education standards and practices board may teach	h any			
21		grade from five through eight, provided the individual has:				
22		a. A major in middle level education; or				
23		b. A major equivalency in middle level education.				
24	3.	An individual who is licensed to teach at the secondary level by the education				
25		standards and practices board or approved to teach at the secondary level by the	he_			
26		education standards and practices board may teach any area at any grade from	n five_			
27		through twelve, provided the individual has:				
28		a. A major in the area being taught;				
29		b. A major equivalency in the area being taught;				
30	c. A minor in the area being taught; or					
31		d. A minor equivalency in the area being taught.
