- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 2 of section 39-01-01 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the definitions of emergency vehicles.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 2 of section 39-01-01 of the North Dakota Century 5 Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 2. "Authorized emergency vehicles":
 - "Class A" authorized emergency vehicles means:
 - Vehicles of a governmentally owned fire department.
 - Vehicles when operated by or under the control of a police officer having authority to enforce the provisions of this title or by a salaried employee of a municipal police department within the municipality or by a sheriff or deputy sheriff not including special deputy sheriffs, or by the director of the department of corrections and rehabilitation and the director's authorized agents who have successfully completed training in the operation of class A authorized emergency vehicles.
 - Vehicles clearly identifiable as property of the department of corrections and (3) rehabilitation when operated or under the control of the director of the department of corrections and rehabilitation.
 - (4) Ambulances and official vehicles designated and marked as quick reaction units or crash rescue unitsother vehicles authorized by licensure granted under chapter 23-27.
 - Vehicles operated by or under the control of the director, district deputy (5) director, or a district deputy game warden of the game and fish department.

3	(7)	Vehicles designated for the use of the adjutant general or assistant adjutant
4		general in cases of emergency.
5	(8)	Vehicles operated by or under the control of the director of the parks and
6		recreation department.
7	(9)	Vehicles operated by or under the control of a licensed railroad police officer
8		and used for law enforcement purposes.
9	(10)	Vehicles operated by or under the control of the state forester.
10	(11)	Vehicles operated by or under the control of the bureau of criminal
11		investigation and used for law enforcement purposes.
12	(12)	Vehicles operated by or under the control of the state department of health
13		in cases of emergencies.
14	b. "Cla	ass B" authorized emergency vehicles means wreckers and such other
15	eme	ergency vehicles as are authorized by the local authorities.
16	c. "Cla	ass C" authorized emergency vehicles means:
17	(1)	Vehicles used by the state division of homeland security or local division of
18		emergency management organizations.
19	(2)	Vehicles used by volunteer firefighters while performing their assigned
20		disaster and emergency responsibilities.
21	(3)	Vehicles, other than ambulances, used by emergency medical services
22		personnel.
