1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state department

2 of health; and to declare an emergency.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the state department of health for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the state department of health, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019, as follows:

19	income line item included in section 1 of this Act includes \$250,000, or so much of the sum as				
20	may be necessary, to be made available to the state department of health from the environment				
21	and rangeland protection fund, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30,				
22	2019. This amount includes \$50,000 for a grant to the North Dakota stockmen's association				
23	environmental services program.				
24	SECTION 4. INSURANCE TAX DISTRIBUTION FUND. The estimated income line item				
25	included in section 1 of this Act includes \$1,250,000, or so much of the sum as may be				
26	necessary, to be made available to the state department of health from the insurance tax				
27	distribution fund, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.				
28	SECTION 5. STRATEGIC INVESTMENT AND IMPROVEMENTS FUND. The estimated				
29	income line item included in section 1 of this Act includes \$500,000, or so much of the sum as				
30	may be necessary, to be made available to the state department of health from the strategic
