1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the state auditor; and

2 to amend and reenact section 54-10-10 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the salary

3 of the state auditor.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION. The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds 6 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state 7 treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and 8 other income, to the state auditor for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the state 9 auditor, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019, as follows:

19 SECTION 2. AMENDMENT. Section 54-10-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is

- 21 **54-10-10**. Salary of state auditor.

22 The annual salary of the state auditor is one hundred two thousand six hundred eighty-nine-

23 dollars through June 30, 2016, and one hundred five thousand seven hundred seventy dollars
