1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the retirement and

2 investment office; and to provide for a transfer.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 **SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds 5 as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys from special funds derived from 6 income for the purpose of defraying the expenses of the retirement and investment office, for 7 the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019, as follows:

16 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATION LINE ITEM TRANSFERS. Upon approval of the board, the 17 retirement and investment office may transfer from their contingency line item in section 1 of 18 this Act to all other line items. The agency shall notify the office of management and budget of 19 each transfer made pursuant to this section.
