- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact a new section under chapter 54-27 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to acceptance of federal funds; and to provide for a legislative
- 3 management study of statutory and regulatory requirements placed on North Dakota state
- 4 government agencies by United States government agencies.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 54-27 of the North Dakota Century Code is created 7 and enacted as follows:
- 8 Federal funding requirements - State agency analysis.
- 9 Each state agency, excluding entities under the control of the state board of higher
- 10 education, prior to applying for or accepting federal grant funds, shall:
- 11 Consider the federal requirements that the state must comply with as a condition of 12 receipt of the federal funds;
- 13 <u>2.</u> Determine that acceptance of the federal funds does not subject the state to undue 14 federal oversight or regulations; and
- 15 Determine that the federal requirements are not in conflict with legislative intent.
- 16 SECTION 2. LEGISLATIVE MANAGEMENT STUDY - STATUTORY AND REGULATORY
- 17 REQUIREMENTS PLACED ON NORTH DAKOTA STATE GOVERNMENT AGENCIES BY
- UNITED STATES GOVERNMENT AGENCIES. During the 2017-18 interim, the legislative 19 management shall consider studying the statutory and regulatory requirements placed on North
- 20 Dakota state government agencies by United States government agencies as a condition of the
- 21 receipt of federal funding to determine whether there are viable options to meet the needs of
- 22 our state without having the federal government's oversight and involvement, which state needs
- 23 can be met if federal funding associated with undesirable regulation or excessive direct and
- 24 indirect costs is refused, and whether the benefits of accepting certain federal funds outweighs

- 1 the requirements of participation in the federal programs. The legislative management shall
- 2 report its findings and recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the
- 3 recommendations, to the sixty-sixth legislative assembly.
