- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact section 34-06-22 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to the state's minimum wage.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

4 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 34-06-22 of the North Dakota Century Code is

5 amended and reenacted as follows:

8		com	missioner, every employer shall pay to each of the employer's employees:	
9		a.	Effective July 24, 2007<u>January 1, 2018</u>, a wage of at least five<u>nine</u> dollars and	
10			eighty-fivetwenty-five cents per hour;	
11		b.	Effective July 24, 2008, a wage of at least six dollars and fifty-five cents per hour;

13		C.	Effective July 24, 2009, a wage of at least seven dollars and twenty-five cents per-	
14			hourJanuary 1, 2019, and annually thereafter, a wage identified by the	
15			commissioner which is adjusted by the increase, if any, in the cost of living.	
16	2.	Ann	ually, the commissioner shall adjust the wage as provided under subsection 1.	
17		<u>The</u>	commissioner shall calculate the increase in the cost of living by measuring the	
18		perc	entage increase as of August of the immediately preceding year over the level as	
19		<u>mea</u>	sured as of August of the previous year of the consumer price index for all urban	
20		cons	sumers (all items, United States city average) as published by the bureau of labor	
21		<u>stati</u>	stics of the department of labor, with the amount of the minimum wage increase, if	
22		<u>any,</u>	rounded up to the nearest five cents. Under no circumstances may the	
23		<u>com</u>	missioner decrease the minimum wage. By October 15 of each year, the

- 2 <u>commissioner's internet home page.</u>
- 3 <u>3.</u> This section does not limit the authority of the commissioner to adopt rules
- 4 establishing a state minimum wage rate that differs from is higher than the rates
- 5 established under subsection 1.
