## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1.** A new section to chapter 12.1-20 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as follows:

## Sexual High-risk sexual offender residence near schools prohibited.

- 1. A sexual offender, as defined in section 12.1-32-15An individual assessed as a high-risk sexual offender in accordance with subsection 12 of section 12.1-32-15, may not reside or loiter within five hundred feet [152.4 meters] of a childcare facility or provider, or a public or nonpublic preschool or elementary, middle, or high school-if the sexual offender:
- a. Has pled guilty or been found guilty of or has been adjudicated delinquent of a class A misdemeanor or felony sexual offense against a minor;
- b. Is required to register under section 12.1-32-15 or equivalent law of another state:
  - c. Is a sexually dangerous individual as defined in 25-03.3-01; or
- d. Has been assessed as a high-risk sexual offender in accordance with subsection 12 of 12.1-32-15.
  - 2. As used in this section:
- 21 <u>a. "Reside" "reside" means to live permanently or be situated for a considerable</u>
  22 <u>time in a home or a particular place.</u>
- <u>b.</u> <u>"Loiter" means to be dilatory, to stand idly around, to linger, delay, or wander
   about, or to remain, abide, or tarry in a public place.

3. A violation of this section is a class A misdemeanor.
