- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 2 of section 16.1-08.1-02, subsection 1 of
- 2 section 16.1-08-03, section 16.1-08.1-03.1, subsection 2 of section 16.1-08.1-03.3,
- 3 subsection 2 of section 16.1-08.1-03.5, subsection 2 of section 16.1-08.1-03.8, subsection 1 of
- 4 section 16.1-08.1-03.9, subsection 2 of section 16.1-08.1-03.12, subsection 6 of
- 5 section 16.1-08.1-03.13, and section 16.1-08.1-04 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating
- 6 to political contribution statements.

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7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 8 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 2 of section 16.1-08.1-02 of the North Dakota 9 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 2. The candidate committee, or candidate for statewide office who does not have a candidate committee, and any candidate for legislative office shall include in the statement the name and mailing address of all contributors who contributed in excess of two hundred dollars in the aggregate during the reporting period to the candidate committee, or candidate for statewide office who does not have a candidate committee, and any candidate for legislative office, the aggregated amount of the reportable contributions from each contributor and the date the last reportable contribution from each contributor was received. For each listed contributor, the aggregate contribution amount must be designated as money, an in-kind contribution, or a combination of money and an in-kind contribution.
 - **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 1 of section 16.1-08.1-03 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 1. Any political party that receives contributions in excess of two hundred dollars in the aggregate during the reporting period shall file a statement containing the aggregated total of all contributions received from a person or political committee which exceed

two hundred dollars in amount. The statement must include the name and mailing address of all contributors listed. For each contributor listed, the statement must include the aggregated amount of the reportable contributions, whether the contributions were money, in-kind contributions, or a combination of money and in-kind contributions, and the date the last reportable contribution was received. For a state political party, the statement must include a list of the name and mailing address of each recipient of an expenditure exceeding two hundred dollars in the aggregate. For each expenditure recipient listed, the list must include the aggregated amount of the reportable expenditures and the date the last expenditure was made.

SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Section 16.1-08.1-03.1 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

16.1-08.1-03.1. Contributions statement required of persons and measure committees circulating or promoting passage or defeat of initiated or referred measure.

- Any person or measure committee, as described in section 16.1-08.1-01, that is soliciting or accepting a contribution for the purpose of aiding or opposing the circulation or passage of a statewide initiative or referendum petition or measure placed upon a statewide ballot by action of the legislative assembly at any election shall file a statement in accordance with this subsection if the person has received any contribution in excess of one hundred dollars. The statement must include the name and mailing address of each person that contributed in excess of one hundred dollars to the person, the amount of each reportable contribution, whether the contribution was money, an in-kind contribution, or a combination of money and an in-kind contribution, and the date each reportable contribution was received. The statement must include the name and mailing address of each recipient of an expenditure exceeding one hundred dollars in the aggregate, the amount of each reportable expenditure, and the date the expenditure was made.
- 2. A person or measure committee as described in section 16.1-08.1-01 which is soliciting or accepting a contribution for the purpose of aiding or opposing the circulation or passage of a statewide initiative or referendum petition or measure placed upon a statewide ballot by action of the legislative assembly may not accept a contribution of more than one hundred dollars from an out-of-state person or political

- committee unless the contribution is accompanied by a certified statement from the contributor listing the name, address, and amount contributed by each person that contributed more than one hundred dollars of the contribution, and whether the contribution was money, an in-kind contribution, or a combination of money and an in-kind contribution. The statement must indicate if no person contributed in excess of one hundred dollars of the out-of-state person's or political committee's overall contribution. The certified statement must also list the occupation, employer, and principal place of business for each individual who contributed more than one hundred dollars of the contribution. The person soliciting or accepting a contribution for the purpose of aiding the circulation of a statewide initiative or referendum petition or of promoting passage or defeat of a statewide initiated or referred measure shall include this statement with the contribution statement required to be filed under subsection 1.
- 3. The statement required of a person or measure committee under subsection 1 must be filed with the secretary of state no later than the thirty-second day before the date of the election in which the measure appears or would have appeared on the ballot complete from the beginning of that calendar year through the fortieth day before the date of the election. A complete statement for the entire calendar year for each statement required to be filed under this section must be filed no later than the thirty-first day of January of the following year. Even if a person required to report according to this section has not received any contributions in excess of one hundred dollars during the reporting period, the person shall file a statement as required by this chapter. A statement filed according to this section during the reporting period must show the following:
 - The gross total of all contributions received and expenditures made in excess of one hundred dollars;
 - The gross total of all contributions received and expenditures made of one hundred dollars, or less; and
 - c. The cash on hand in the filer's account at the start and close of the reporting period.

SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Subsection 2 of section 16.1-08.1-03.3 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

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- 1 All political action committees, as described in section 16.1-08.1-01, formed for the 2 purpose of administering the segregated fund provided for in this section shall file a 3 statement showing the name and mailing address of each contributor of an amount in 4 excess of two hundred dollars in the aggregate for the reporting period and a listing of 5 all expenditures of an amount in excess of two hundred dollars in the aggregate made 6 for political purposes with the secretary of state. The statement must include the 7 amount of each reportable contribution and the date it was received, and the amount 8 of each reportable expenditure and the date it was made. Each reported contribution 9 must be designated as money, an in-kind contribution, or a combination of money and 10 an in-kind contribution. A year-end statement covering the entire calendar year must 11 be filed no later than the thirty-first day of January of the following year. A pre-election 12 statement must be filed no later than the thirty-second day before any primary, special, 13 or general election and must be complete from the beginning of the calendar year 14 through the fortieth day before the election. Even if a political action committee has not 15 received any contributions or made any expenditures in excess of two hundred dollars 16 during the reporting period, the political action committee shall file a statement as 17 required by this chapter. A statement filed according to this section during the reporting 18 period must show the following: 19
 - The gross total of all contributions received and expenditures made in excess of two hundred dollars;
 - The gross total of all contributions received and expenditures made of two hundred dollars, or less; and
 - c. The cash on hand in the filer's account at the start and close of the reporting period.

SECTION 5. AMENDMENT. Subsection 2 of section 16.1-08.1-03.5 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

2. A corporation, cooperative corporation, limited liability company, or association may make a donation of property or money to a state political party or nonprofit entity affiliated with or under the control of a state political party for deposit in a separate and segregated fund. Money in the fund must be used exclusively by the state political party or nonprofit entity affiliated with or under the control of a state political party for

purchasing, maintaining, or renovating a building and for the purchase of fixtures for the building. A state political party or nonprofit entity affiliated with or under the control of a state political party receiving a donation under this subsection shall file a statement with the secretary of state no later than the thirty-first day of January of each calendar year. The statement must include the name and mailing address of each donor, the amount of each donation, the date each donation was received, whether the donation was money, property, or a combination of money and property. all expenditures made from the fund during the previous calendar year, and cash on hand in the fund at the start and close of the reporting period. Any income and financial gain generated from a building purchased, maintained, or renovated from donations authorized under this subsection and not otherwise authorized by law must be deposited in the building fund and must be reported when the political party or nonprofit entity files the statement required under this subsection.

SECTION 6. AMENDMENT. Subsection 2 of section 16.1-08.1-03.8 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

2. A multicandidate political committee shall file a statement containing the aggregated total of all contributions showing the name and mailing address of each contributor who contributed in excess of two hundred dollars in the aggregate to the committee during a reporting period, the aggregated amount of the reportable contributions in excess of two hundred dollars contributed by each listed contributor, whether that amount was money, an in-kind contribution, or a combination of money and an in-kind contribution, and the date the lasteach reportable contribution was received.

SECTION 7. AMENDMENT. Subsection 1 of section 16.1-08.1-03.9 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

- 1. A judicial district candidate or a candidate committee for a judicial district candidate shall make and file a statement in accordance with this section. The candidate or candidate committee shall include in the statement:
 - a. The name and mailing address of all contributors who made contributions in excess of two hundred dollars in the aggregate for the purpose of influencing the nomination for election, or election, of the candidate;

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- 1 The aggregated amount of the contributions from each listed contributor, and 2 whether the aggregated contributions were money, in-kind contributions, or a 3 combination of money and in-kind contributions; 4 The date the last contribution was received from each listed contributor; C. 5 The gross total of all contributions received in excess of two hundred dollars; d. 6 e. The gross total of all contributions received of two hundred dollars, or less; and 7 f. The cash on hand in the filer's account at the start and close of the reporting 8 period. 9 SECTION 8. AMENDMENT. Subsection 2 of section 16.1-08.1-03.12 of the North Dakota 10 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 11 An incidental committee that solicits or accepts contributions for any political purpose 12 shall file a statement in the office of the secretary of state no later than the 13 thirty-second day before the date of any primary, special, or general election. The 14 statement must be complete from the beginning of that calendar year through the 15 fortieth day before the date of the primary, special, or general election. The committee 16 shall file a complete statement for the entire calendar year no later than the thirty-first 17 day of January of the following year in which the committee received a reportable 18 contribution. Even if an incidental committee has not received any contributions in 19 excess of two hundred dollars during the reporting period, the committee shall file a 20 statement as required under this chapter. A statement filed under this subsection 21 during the reporting period must show the following: 22 The gross total of all contributions received in excess of two hundred dollars; a. 23 The name and mailing address of each contributor that contributed in excess of b. 24 two hundred dollars in the aggregate to the committee during a reporting period, 25 and whether the contributor contributed money, in-kind contributions, or a 26 combination of money and in-kind contributions; 27 The gross total of all contributions received of two hundred dollars or less; C. 28
 - The date the last reportable contribution was received; d.
 - The cash on hand in the filer's account at the start and close of the reporting e. period; and

23	SECTION 10. AMENDMENT. Section 16.1-08.1-04 of the North Dakota Century Code is	
24	amended and reenacted as follows:

27	If any candidate, political party, or political committee receives contributions in excess of	
28	five hundred dollars in the aggregate within the thirty-nine days immediately preceding any	
29	election from any individual contributor, that candidate, political party, political committee, or	
30	person shall make and file a supplemental statement in the same form as required by section	
31	16.1-08.1-02	, 16.1-08.1-03, 16.1-08.1-03.1, 16.1-08.1-03.3, 16.1-08.1-03.8, 16.1-08.1-03.9,

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- 1 16.1-08.1-03.10, 16.1-08.1-03.11, or 16.1-08.1-03.12 stating the name and street address of the
- 2 contributor and the aggregated amount of the contribution, and file the statement in the
- 3 appropriate office within forty-eight hours of the receipt of the contribution.
