1 A concurrent resolution requesting the Legislative Management to consider studying the 2 legalization of marijuana. 3 WHEREAS, over \$1,000,000,000,000 has been spent nationally enforcing drug laws, 4 including those pertaining to marijuana, since the War on Drugs was initiated by President 5 Nixon in the 1970s; and 6 WHEREAS, the United States has become a nation of mass incarceration, imprisoning over 7 two million citizens, representing the highest imprisonment rate of any nation in the world; and 8 WHEREAS, states that have legalized marijuana have experienced increased tax revenue; 9 and 10 WHEREAS, the citizens of North Dakota recently voted to allow the use of marijuana for 11 medical purposes; 12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF 13 NORTH DAKOTA, THE SENATE CONCURRING THEREIN: 14 That the Legislative Management consider studying the legalization of marijuana; and 15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Legislative Management report its findings and 16 recommendations, together with any legislation required to implement the recommendations, to
