- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 43-04-26, 43-04-31, 43-04-32, 43-04-33,
- 2 43-04-35, 43-04-36, 43-04-39, 43-04-42, and 43-04-45 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 3 relating to the repeal of apprentice barbering requirements; and to repeal sections 43-04-22,
- 4 43-04-23, 43-04-28, 43-04-29, and 43-04-34 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to the
- 5 repeal of apprentice barbering requirements.

## BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 43-04-26 of the North Dakota Century Code is
  amended and reenacted as follows:
- 9 43-04-26. Application for admission to barber school for postgraduate course.
- NoA school or college of barbering may <u>not</u> enroll or admit any student in a postgraduate course thereof, unless <u>suchthe</u> student <u>shall filefiles</u>, in duplicate, an application, duly verified,
- 12 which must show that suchthe applicant:
- 13 1. Has graduated from a school or college of barbering approved by the board;
- Then holds a valid, unexpired, and uncanceled certificate of registration as a
  registered apprentice; or
- Can prove by sworn affidavits that the applicant has practiced as a barber in another state of the United States for at least two years immediately prior to making such the application.
- 19 One copy of suchthe application must be retained by the college or school so admitting or
- 20 enrolling such the student and the other must be filed by such school or college with saidthe
- 21 board. Nothing in this This section contained may not be construed as limiting or modifying the
- 22 provisions of sections 43-04-31 and 43-04-35.
- 23 **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-04-31 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

1	43-04-31. Qualifications for certificate of registration as registered barber.		
2	A person is qualified to receive a certificate of registration to practice barbering if the		
3	person:		
4	1.	Is qualified in accordance with the provisions of section 43-04-23;	
5	2.	Is at least eighteen years of age;	
6	3.	Is of good moral character and temperate habits;	
7	4.	Has practiced as a registered apprentice for a period of twelve months under the	
8		immediate supervision of a registered barber; and	
9	<del>5.</del>	Has passed a satisfactory examination conducted by the board to determine that	
10		person's fitness to practice barbering.	
11	SECTION 3. AMENDMENT. Section 43-04-32 of the North Dakota Century Code is		
12	amended and reenacted as follows:		
13	43-04-32. Barber and apprentice - Application for examination.		
14	Any person, who desires to take the examination for a certificate of registration to practice		
15	as a registered barber or for a certificate of registration to practice as a registered apprentice,		
16	shall make application to the board on blanks prepared and furnished by itthe board and shall		
17	enclose with the application all of the following:		
18	1.	Proof, under oath, of the person's qualifications.	
19	2.	A five-inch by three-inch [12.7-centimeter by 7.62-centimeter] signed photograph of	
20		that person. The person also shall present such a photograph to the board when the	
21		person appears for examination.	
22	3.	The required fee.	
23	4.	A certificate showing graduation from a public or recognized private high school or an	
24		equivalent education as determined by an examination conducted by the board;	
25		provided, however, that two years armed service should be termed equivalent	
26		education.	
27	SECTION 4. AMENDMENT. Section 43-04-33 of the North Dakota Century Code is		

43-04-33. Examinations - Barber - Apprentice barber.

amended and reenacted as follows:

The board, not less than four times each year, at such times and places as it may determine, shall conduct examinations of applicants for certificates of registration to practice as

- 1 registered barbers and of applicants for certificates of registration to practice as registered
- 2 apprentices. Each examination must include both a practical demonstration and a written and
- 3 oral test, and must embrace the subjects usually taught in schools of barbering approved by the
- 4 board.

- 5 **SECTION 5. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-04-35 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 6 amended and reenacted as follows:
  - 43-04-35. Failure to pass examination for registered barber When applicant may be
- 8 re-examined.
- An applicant for a certificate of registration to practice as a registered barber who fails to
- pass a satisfactory examination conducted by the board shall continue to practice as an
- 11 apprentice for must wait an additional sixthree months before that person again is entitled to
- 12 take the examination for registration as a barber.
- 13 **SECTION 6. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-04-36 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 14 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 43-04-36. Barber and apprentice Certificate of registration When issued.
- The board shall issue to an applicant a certificate of registration as a registered barber
- 17 whenever the applicant has complied with the provisions of section 43-04-31, and it shall issue-
- 18 a certificate of registration as a registered apprentice whenever the applicant has complied with
- 19 the provisions of section 43-04-23.
- 20 **SECTION 7. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-04-39 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 21 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 43-04-39. Renewal and restoration of certificates of barber and apprentice barber.
- 23 Every registered barber and every registered apprentice who continues in active practice or
- service, annually, on or before July first, shall renew that person's certificate of registration and
- 25 pay the required fee. Every certificate of registration which has not been renewed during the
- 26 month of July in any year expires the first day of August in that year. A registered barber or a
- 27 registered apprentice whose certificate of registration has expired may have that person's
- 28 certificate restored immediately upon payment of the required restoration fee. Any registered
- 29 barber who retires from the practice of barbering for not more than five years may renew that
- person's certificate upon payment of the required restoration fee.

1	SECTION 8. AMENDMENT. Section 43-04-42 of the North Dakota Century Code is		
2	amended and	d reenacted as follows:	
3	43-04-42	. Fees.	
4	1. The	board may charge applicants the following fees:	
5	a.	For examination and issuance of a certificate to practice master barbering, one	
6		hundred dollars.	
7	b.	For examination and issuance of a certificate to practice as an apprentice barber,	
8		fifty dollars.	
9	<del>C.</del>	For renewal of a master barber's certificate, one hundred dollars.	
10	<del>d.</del> c.	For restoration of an expired master barber's certificate, a twenty dollar penalty	
11		fee in addition to the regular renewal fee.	
12	e.	For renewal of an apprentice barber's certificate, twenty dollars.	
13	f <del>.</del>	For restoration of an expired apprentice barber's certificate, a twenty dollar-	
14		penalty fee in addition to the regular renewal fee.	
15	<del>g.</del> d.	For a permit to operate a barber school or college, an annual fee of one hundred	
16		twenty-five dollars.	
17	<del>h.</del> e.	For issuance of an annual barbershop license, fifty dollars, to be paid by each	
18		shopowner in advance.	
19	i. <u>f.</u>	For issuance of a certificate to an applicant who qualifies under section	
20		43-04-38.1, one hundred seventy-five dollars.	
21	<del>j.</del> g.	For restoration of an expired barbershop license, a twenty dollar penalty fee in	
22		addition to the annual license fee.	
23	<del>k.</del> <u>h.</u>	For renewal of an instructor's license, twenty-five dollars.	
24	2. Eac	h application to open or establish a barbershop in this state must be accompanied	
25	by a	a fee of one hundred dollars to cover expenses of inspection, which must be	
26	reta	ined by the board and deposited as other fees.	
27	3. A dı	uplicate license, certificate, or permit must be issued upon:	
28	a.	Filing a statement verified by the oath of the applicant which explains the loss;	
29	b.	Submitting a signed photograph of the applicant; and	
30	C	Paying a fee of ten dollars for the issuance of the duplicate	

- 4. Anyone who becomes a member of the armed forces of the United States in time of war, while holding a license as a barber or apprentice, and while in good standing as to payment of fees, may obtain a certificate restoration without payment of the restoration fee.
- 5 **SECTION 9. AMENDMENT.** Section 43-04-45 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
- 7 43-04-45. Penalty.

- 8 Any person who shall:
- 9 1. Violate any of the provisions of sections 43-04-21, 43-04-22, 43-04-30, and 43-04-43;
- Permit any person in that person's employ, supervision, or control to practice as an apprentice or a barber unless the person employed, supervised, or controlled has a
  certificate of registration as a registered apprentice or barber;
- Obtain or attempt to obtain a certificate of registration by the payment of money other
  than the required fee, or any other thing of value, or by fraudulent misrepresentations;
  - 4. Practice or attempt to practice by fraudulent misrepresentations; or
- 16 5. Willfully fail to display a certificate of registration as is required by this chapter,
- 17 is guilty of a class B misdemeanor. A violation of any provision of this chapter or of any rule,
- subpoena, or order of the board lawfully made pursuant hereto, except as otherwise provided
- 19 herein, is a class B misdemeanor.
- 20 **SECTION 10. REPEAL.** Sections 43-04-22, 43-04-23, 43-04-28, 43-04-29, and 43-04-34 of the North Dakota Century Code are repealed.
