SENATE BILL NO. 2107

- 1 A BILL for an Act to create and enact section 37-01-47 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 2 relating to health insurance coverage for national guard service members; to amend and
- 3 reenact sections 37-04-08 and 37-07-05 of the North Dakota Century Code, relating to pay and
- 4 benefits of national guard members; and to declare an emergency.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 6 **SECTION 1.** Section 37-01-47 of the North Dakota Century Code is created and enacted as 7 follows:
- 8 <u>37-01-47. Health insurance coverage while on state active duty.</u>
- 9 <u>During the period of active duty, the national guard may pay any primary health insurance</u>
- 10 <u>premium on behalf of a national guard service member or an employer-sponsored health</u>
- 11 <u>insurance premium cost share paid by the service member while called to state active duty.</u>
- 12 Coverage of qualifying premium payment is subject to rules set forth by the adjutant general's
- 13 office and subject to available funds.
- **SECTION 2. AMENDMENT.** Section 37-04-08 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 15 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 16 37-04-08. Pay received by commissioned officers of the national guard.
- 17 Every commissioned officer of the national guard shall is entitled to receive from this state,
- while engaged in any service ordered by the governor, pay and allowances at the rate allowed
- by law to officers of similar rank and length of service in the United States army. If ordered to
- 20 <u>active duty by the governor in response to an emergency management assistance compact</u>
- 21 request and if the requesting state pays state active duty pay at a higher rate than this state, the
- 22 commissioned officer is entitled to the higher rate of pay. Each commissioned officer of the
- 23 national guard shall also is entitled to receive a state active duty pay enhancement of onethree
- 24 hundred dollars for every fourteen consecutive daysmonth spent on state active duty or a

- 1 prorated amount for each day of state active duty up to three hundred dollars per month. The
- 2 adjutant general and deputy assistant adjutant general when receiving salary from the state and
- 3 not on active duty in a federal status shallare entitled to receive such compensation as may be
- 4 appropriated by the legislative assembly for that purpose, provided that when the adjutant
- 5 general receives compensation from the government of the United States as director of
- 6 selective service, such compensation must be deducted from the compensation otherwise due
- 7 the adjutant general from the state and the adjutant general may be paid from state funds only
- 8 the difference, if any, between the compensation from the United States and the compensation
- 9 provided in this section.
- 10 **SECTION 3. AMENDMENT.** Section 37-07-05 of the North Dakota Century Code is
- 11 amended and reenacted as follows:
- 12 37-07-05. Pay and allowances of enlisted national guard members Deductions
- 13 allowed.

- 1. Each enlisted member of the national guard, when called into active service by the
- governor, shall is entitled to receive pay at the rate provided for enlisted personnel of
- similar grade, rating, and term of enlistment in the national guard of the United States,
- except that such daily pay rate for each of the grades hereafter listed must be
- 18 increased by the percentage set forth after such grade as follows:
- 19 1. a. E-3 55%
- 20 <u>2.</u> <u>b.</u> E-4 45%
- 21 <u>3.</u> <u>c.</u> E-5 35%
- 22 4. d. E-6 25%
- 23 5. <u>e.</u> E-7 15%
- 24 6. <u>f.</u> E-8 10%
- 25 <u>2. If ordered by the governor in response to an emergency management assistance</u>
- 26 <u>compact request and if the requesting state pays state active duty pay at a higher rate</u>
- 27 <u>than this state, the enlisted member may receive the higher rate of pay if the</u>
- 28 <u>requesting state reimburses this state for the higher rate of pay.</u> Each enlisted member
- shall also is entitled to receive transportation, shelter, and subsistence. The value of
- articles issued to any member of a company or battery and not returned in good order
- 31 on demand, and all legal fines or forfeitures, may be deducted from the member's pay.

1	Each enlisted member shall also is entitled to receive a state active duty pay
2	enhancement of onethree hundred dollars for every fourteen consecutive daysmonth
3	spent on state active duty or a prorated amount for each day of state active duty up to
4	three hundred dollars per month. Pay at an annual encampment must be such as is
5	allowed by federal law.
6	SECTION 4. EMERGENCY. This Act is declared to be an emergency measure.
