- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 7 of section 50-24.5-01 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the definition of eligible beneficiary for the aid to aged, blind, and

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## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Subsection 7 of section 50-24.5-01 of the North Dakota 6 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows: 7 "Eligible beneficiary" means a resident of this state who: 7. 8 (1) Is aged; or 9 Is at least eighteen years of age and is disabled or blind; (2) 10 Has applied for and is eligible to receive and receives benefits under title b. (1) 11 XIX of the Social Security Act [42 U.S.C. 1396 et seq.], and who has applied 12 for and is receiving benefits, if the individual is eligible to receive benefits, 13 under titles II and XVI of the Social Security Act [42 U.S.C. 401-434 and 42 14 U.S.C. 1381 et seq.]; or 15 Has applied for and is eligible to receive and receives benefits under section (2) 16 50-24.1-37 for long-term services and supports pursuant to an asset test 17 established under title XIX of the Social Security Act [42 U.S.C. 1396 18 et seq.] and section 50-24.1-02; 19
  - Meets the requirements of section 23-09.3-08.1; C.
  - d. Based on a functional assessment, is not severely impaired in any of the activities of daily living of toileting, transferring to or from a bed or chair, or eating and:

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1		(1)	Has health, welfare, or safety needs, including a need for supervision or a
2			structured environment, which require care in a licensed adult family foster-
3			care home or an assisted living facility; or
4		(2)	Is impaired in three of the following four instrumental activities of daily living:
5			preparing meals, doing housework, taking medicine, and doing laundry; and
