- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact sections 50-06.2-10 and 50-24.7-02 of the North
- 2 Dakota Century Code, relating to collection of overpayments for service payments for elderly
- 3 and disabled program and expanded service payments for elderly and disabled program.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

5 SECTION 1. AMENDMENT. Section 50-06.2-10 of the North Dakota Century Code is

6 amended and reenacted as follows:

7	50-06.2-10. Service payments for elderly and disabled program eligibility.				
8	1.	The state agency may not require an individual to apply for services under chapter			
9		50-24.1 as a condition of being eligible to apply for services under the service			
10		payments for elderly and disabled program:			

- a. If the individual's estimated monthly home and community-based services
 benefits, excluding the cost of case management, are between the income level
 established in section 50-24.1-02.6 and the lowest level of the fee schedule for
 services under this chapter; or
- b. If the individual is receiving a service that is not available under chapter 50-24.1.
- The home and community-based services case manager shall notify the state agency
 upon use of an exception authorized under subsection 1.
- An overpayment, whether resulting from an eligible individual's or guardian of the
 eligible individual's legal representative's concealment, misrepresentation, or fraud, or
- 20 <u>from assistance granted pending a decision on an appeal adverse to the appellant</u>,
- 21 and whenever made, is subject to recovery by the state agency. An overpayment may
- 22 be collected from any person that benefited from, or that was responsible for, the
- 23 overpayment. A statute of limitations or similar statute or the doctrine of laches does
- 24 <u>not bar a claim under this chapter.</u>

10		services provided to eligible individuals:			
11		a.	Adult day care;		
12		b.	Adult family foster care;		
13		C.	Case management;		
14		d.	Chore services;		
15		e.	Family home care;		
16		f.	Homemaker services;		
17		g.	Nonmedical transportation;		
18		h.	Respite care; and		
19		i.	Other services the department determines to be essential and appropriate to		
20			sustain an individual in the individual's home and community and to delay or		
21			prevent institutional care.		
22	3.	Take	eThe department shall take actions, give directions, and adopt rules as necessary		
23		to ca	arry out the provisions of this chapter.
