- 1 A BILL for an Act to amend and reenact subsection 3 of section 50-24.6-04 of the North Dakota
- 2 Century Code, relating to the prior authorization program.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

- 4 **SECTION 1. AMENDMENT.** Subsection 3 of section 50-24.6-04 of the North Dakota 5 Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:
 - 3. a. ExceptFor individuals twenty-one years of age and older, except for quantity limits that may be no less than the pharmaceutical manufacturer's package insert, or brand name drugs with a generic equivalent drug for which the cost to the state postrebate is less than the brand name drugs, in the aggregate, or generic drugs with a brand name equivalent drug for which the cost to the state postrebate is less than the generic drug, the department may not prior authorize the following medication classes:
 - a. (1) Antipsychotics;
 - b. (2) Antidepressants;
 - e. (3) Anticonvulsants;
 - d. (4) Antiretrovirals, for the treatment of human immunodeficiency virus; and
 - e. (5) Antineoplastic agents, for the treatment of cancer; and
 - f. (6) Stimulant medication used for the treatment of attention deficit disorder and attention deficit hyperactivity disorder.
 - b. For individuals under twenty-one years of age, except for quantity limits that may be no less than the pharmaceutical manufacturer's package insert, brand name drugs with a generic equivalent drug for which the cost to the state postrebate is less than the brand name drugs, in the aggregate, or generic drugs with a brand name equivalent drug for which the cost to the state postrebate is less than the

10	<u>C.</u>	<u>The</u>	restrictions of subdivision b do not apply for individuals under twenty-one
11		year	s of age, who have five or more concurrent prescriptions for psychotropic
12		med	ications.
13	<u>d.</u>	<u>Prio</u>	r authorization for individuals under twenty-one years of age is required for
14		<u>five</u>	or more concurrent prescriptions for antipsychotics, antidepressants,
15		<u>antic</u>	convulsants, benzodiazepines, mood stabilizers, sedative, hypnotics, or
16		med	ications used for the treatment of attention deficit hyperactivity disorder.
17		Pres	scribers requesting authorization to exceed the limits shall consult with the
18		<u>depa</u>	artment or through its agent. The department shall grant authorization to
19		exce	eed the limits after a prescriber requesting authorization consults with a board
20		<u>certi</u>	fied pediatric psychiatrist approved by the department.
