- 1 A BILL for an Act to provide an appropriation for defraying the expenses of the agriculture
- 2 commissioner; to amend and reenact section 4-01-21 of the North Dakota Century Code,
- 3 relating to the salary of the agriculture commissioner; and to provide for transfers.

## 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATIVE ASSEMBLY OF NORTH DAKOTA:

**SECTION 1. APPROPRIATION.** The funds provided in this section, or so much of the funds as may be necessary, are appropriated out of any moneys in the general fund in the state treasury, not otherwise appropriated, and from special funds derived from federal funds and other income, to the agriculture commissioner for the purpose of defraying the expenses of that agency, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019, as follows:

SECTION 2. ONE-TIME FUNDING. The following amounts reflect the 2015-17 one-time funding items approved by the sixty-fourth legislative assembly:

8 SECTION 3. TRANSFER - ENVIRONMENT AND RANGELAND PROTECTION FUND -

**MINOR USE PESTICIDE FUND.** The agriculture commissioner shall transfer \$325,000 from the environment and rangeland protection fund to the minor use pesticide fund during the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.

12 SECTION 4. ESTIMATED INCOME - ENVIRONMENT AND RANGELAND PROTECTION

**FUND.** The estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$6,455,667, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, from the environment and rangeland protection fund for the purpose of defraying the expenses of various department of agriculture programs, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.

**SECTION 5. ESTIMATED INCOME - GAME AND FISH FUND.** The estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$498,830, or so much of the sum as may be necessary, from the game and fish department operating fund for the purpose of defraying the expenses of various department of agriculture programs, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.

**SECTION 6. ESTIMATED INCOME - STATE WATER COMMISSION - TRANSFER.** The estimated income line item in section 1 of this Act includes the sum of \$250,000 which the state water commission shall transfer to the agriculture commissioner for the wildlife services program, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2017, and ending June 30, 2019.

**SECTION 7. WATERBANK PROGRAM - MATCHING FUNDS.** The salaries and wages line item in section 1 of this Act includes \$50,000 from the general fund for matching funds for the North Dakota outdoor heritage fund grant provided for the waterbank program.

SECTION 8. AMENDMENT. Section 4-01-21 of the North Dakota Century Code is amended and reenacted as follows:

## 1 4-01-21. Salary of agriculture commissioner.

- 2 The annual salary of the agriculture commissioner is one hundred five thousand four-
- 3 hundred ninety-one dollars through June 30, 2016, and one hundred eight thousand six
- 4 hundred fifty-six dollars through June 30, 2018, and one hundred nine thousand seven hundred
- 5 <u>forty-three dollars</u> thereafter.

## 6 SECTION 9. TRANSFER - FEDERAL ENVIRONMENTAL LAW IMPACT REVIEW FUND.

- 7 The office of management and budget shall transfer, from the strategic investment and
- 8 improvements fund, \$1,000,000 of the amount appropriated in the operating expenses line item
- 9 in section 1 of this Act to the federal environmental law impact review fund for the purpose of
- 10 covering expenses related to the waters of the United States lawsuit, for the period beginning
- 11 with the effective date of this Act and ending June 30, 2019.
