FIRST READING OF HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTIONS

HCR 3006: A concurrent resolution to amend and reenact section 7 of article IV of the Constitution of North Dakota, relating to reconvening of the legislative assembly to consider a veto.

Was read the first time and referred to the **Government and Veterans Affairs Committee**.

HCR 3045: A concurrent resolution requesting the Legislative Management to consider studying the feasibility and desirability, potential benefits and efficiencies, and potential implementation processes for unifying the responsibilities and resources of the Game and Fish Department and the Parks and Recreation Department under a single game, fish, parks, and recreation department; and for unifying the law enforcement responsibilities and resources of the Game and Fish Department and the Parks and Recreation Department with and under the Highway Patrol.

HCR 3047: A concurrent resolution directing the Legislative Management to consider studying state and federal veterans' programs, the programs' eligibility requirements, and the efficiency of public or private entities responsible for the administration of state and federal veterans' programs to ensure all current and future North Dakota veterans receive the care, assistance, and benefits to which the veterans are entitled.
